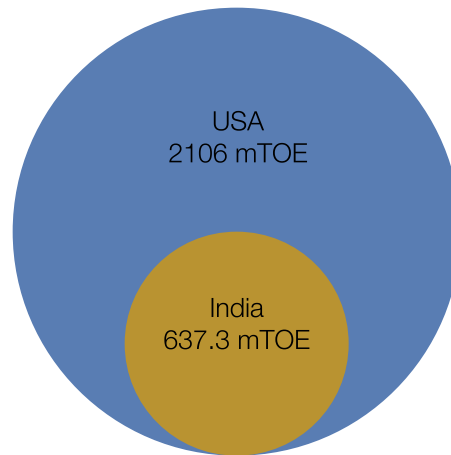

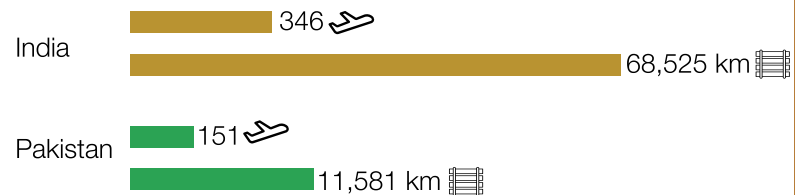


### Total Energy Consumption
