## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN SINDH JANUARY - JUNE 2025 FACT SHEET




## Introduction

The factsheet data on domestic violence in Sindh collected through Right to Information (RTI) from the police department. Domestic violence cases further divided into Physical abuse, Sexual Abuse and psychological abuse. This data also demonstrates number of cases in the legal procedure: challan cases, cases under investigation, cases under trial, conviction, acquittal, withdrawn. The rate represents the number of reported GBV cases per 100,000 women aged 15 and above. It is used to provide a standardized comparison across provinces or districts with varying population sizes. Often, districts with smaller populations may show higher rates despite having fewer total cases. However, when examining absolute numbers, provinces or districts reporting a larger volume of cases are also considered high-risk areas, indicating widespread prevalence.

## **Objectives**

- To assess the prevalence and patterns of domestic violence in Sindh from January to June 2025, focusing on four key forms of abuse physical, sexual, psychological, and financial.
- To identify and analyse gaps in the reporting, investigation, and trial proceedings of domestic violence cases in Sindh.


## **District-wise Breakdown of Reported Cases**
