The TSA Creed

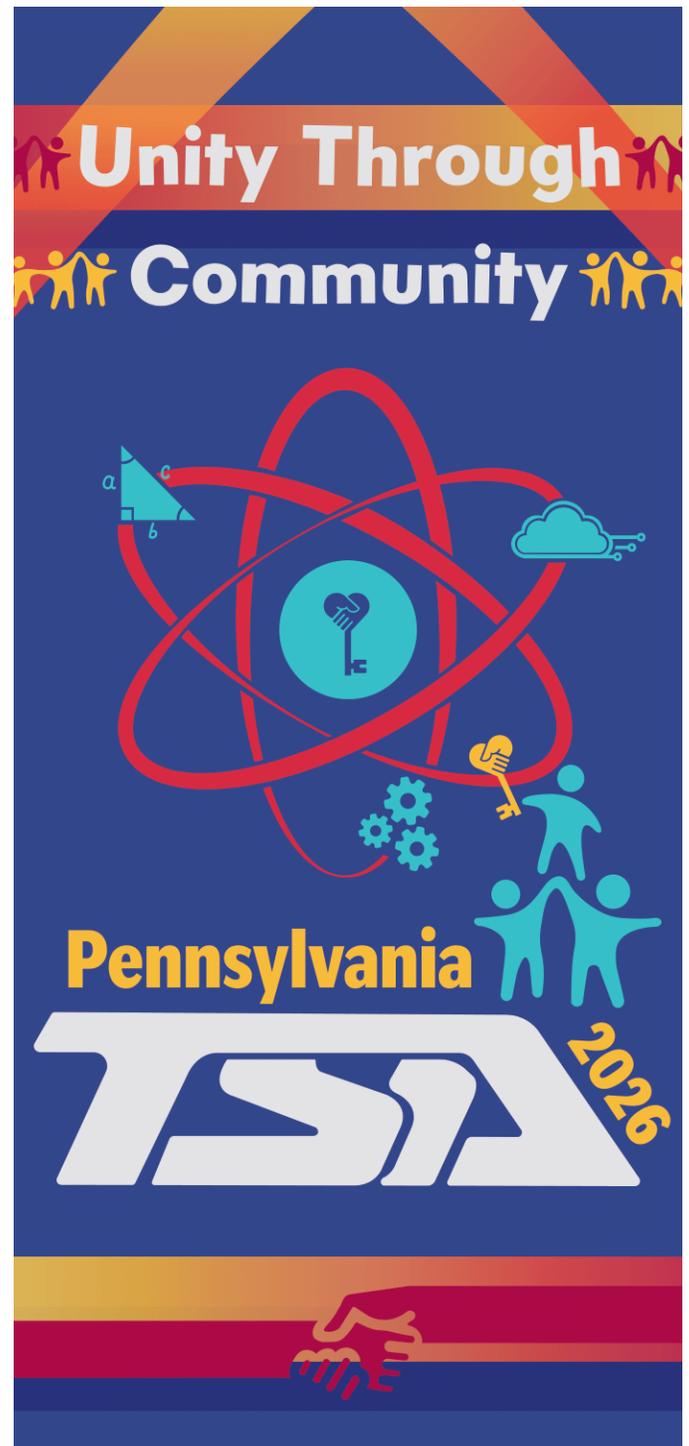

PA-TSA Dress Code

- Guidelines listed below are for all students and advisors.
- Required dress code category will be listed with each event in the conference program.
- I.D. Tags must be worn at all times by students, advisors and guests.
- Items never permitted: hats (any type), weapons of any type (utility knives and x-acto knives must be used under adult supervision), any tobacco products, matches or lighters, and any controlled substance (alcohol or drugs).
- Students are permitted to dress more formally than listed; dressing less formally than specified will result in a rules violation.
- **Failure to meet the guidelines will result in a rules violation.**

Category A - Official TSA Attire

- Blazer: navy blue with official TSA patch
- Ties: scarlet red imprinted with official TSA logo (for males; females may opt to wear the tie but are not required to do so)
- Shirt or blouse: white, button-up with turn down collar or official blue TSA dress shirt/blouse
- Pants or knee length skirt: gray (unacceptable: yoga pants or tights worn as pants, jeans, jeggings, baggy pants, exterior pocket pants, shorts)
- Socks: black or dark blue
- Shoes: black dress shoes, open-toe or dress sandals are permitted (unacceptable: athletic shoes, flip flops, military boots, or work boots)

Category B - Professional TSA Attire

- Collared dress shirt with tie; dress slacks (unacceptable: polo shirt, jeans or shorts)
- Dress or dress blouse; dress slacks or knee length skirt (unacceptable: jeans or shorts, yoga pants or tights worn as pants, jeggings, baggy pants, exterior pocket pants)
- Shoes: best possible

Category C - Business Casual TSA Attire

- Shirt: TSA t-shirt or collared shirt
- Pants: dress slacks, skirt or dress jeans (unacceptable: shorts)
- Shoes: best possible

Category D - Casual Personal Time

- Casual dress permitted
- Sneaker or some type of shoe
- Unacceptable: tank tops, poor taste t-shirts

Advisor Guidelines

1. The advisors are responsible for the proper conduct of all students from their school during the conference. Violations of conduct shall be subject to immediate action by the advisor, conference director or board president. Such action may include sending individuals home immediately and/or disqualifying them from all events.
2. Advisors must be exemplary in their behavior, setting a good example for all students. As a TSA Conference is an extension of the school day, advisors, guests and chaperones must act responsibly, professionally and respectfully at all times. Good sportsmanship is essential and therefore assistance must be provided by advisors to instill in students an understanding of the value of TSA participation as a whole. There is more to life than taking the top spot in every event.
3. Students should only be in the sleeping rooms for which they are registered, unless advisor permission is granted.
4. The advisor's availability in the conference facility is imperative so that students can reach the advisor in the event of an accident, illness or other reason. Advisors are responsible for keeping in their possession at all times a parental permission slip and health information form for each student in attendance.
5. Review the total conference program with your students emphasizing the importance of appearance, attitude, promptness, and courtesy.
6. Be sure you and your students are properly registered in the hotel and understand the rate being charged. The changing of rooms after registering is prohibited. Each school will be held responsible for any charges incurred during the conference, including property damage and telephone calls.

Student Guidelines

1. Students must not leave the conference site or lodging area without the permission and/or accompaniment of their advisor/chaperone.
2. The possession and/or use of any controlled substance (i.e. alcohol, drugs, tobacco) is prohibited. Prescribed medications must be held and distributed by an advisor.
3. Students should only be in the sleeping rooms for which they are registered, unless advisor permission is granted.
4. Students must attend all general sessions and activities for which they are assigned/registered. This includes workshops, competitive events, committee meetings, etc.
5. Name tags must be worn, around the neck, at all times.
6. Students are reminded that the state and school weapon policies are in effect while attending the conference. Any student found in violation of these policies may face legal charges and/or expulsion upon return. (X-acto knives, utility knives and other potentially dangerous tools should be kept by advisors and used only under proper supervision.
7. Improper conduct on the balconies will result in the restriction of balcony use.
8. All students must be in their assigned rooms and quiet during Quiet Hours.
9. A TSA Conference is an extension of the school day, thus all school rules/policies are in effect and anyone found in violation of these rules/policies will be dealt with accordingly.

PA-TSA prides itself on maintaining a culture of civility, tolerance and respect. Accordingly, any behavior that fails to meet this expectation will be addressed by the chapter advisor, State advisor, school principal, State conference planning team and/or the PA-TSA Board of Directors.
