Program Descriptions

Hand Building

Our mixed-level classes offer personalized instruction tailored to you. You'll build your skills progressively, with expert guidance every step of the way. Try your hand at both wheel throwing and hand-building in this fun and supportive environment!

Sculptural Hand Building

Learn the properties of clay, basic hand-building techniques, and surface decoration including glazing and painting your creations. This class is for all skill levels. Bring you ideas to life in this creative setting!

Mastering Your Own Practice

Designed for students with an established art practice. You'll craft your own mission statement and embark on an exciting journey to reach your artistic goals, all while experimenting with and exploring various materials and techniques.

Life Drawing & Painting with a Model

Ideal for students looking to strengthen their drawing and painting skills while developing a deeper understanding of the human figure through working directly with a model during select sessions.

Watercolour: Beg. and Int.

These step-by-step classes focuses on the fundamentals of watercolour, colour theory, washes, and glazes. The intermediate class expands upon this while introducing more advanced techniques and creative concepts.

Still Life Drawing and Painting

Sharpen your observational skills and train your eye to accurately capture light, form, and depth. Through focused drawing and oil painting, you'll explore still life subjects while developing an understanding of composition, tonal values, and colour mixing.

Independent Study

Designed for artists who are ready to develop a cohesive body of work and refine their personal style. You'll work independently while receiving individualized and group feedback to support your artistic direction. Participants may work in the materials of their choice!

Six Artists, Six Techniques

Explore the distinct techniques of six historical and contemporary artists. Each lesson will introduce you to the unique methods that shaped their work, and the decision-making process behind them. You will then experiment and adapt as you work on your own pieces.

Currents In Events
