- Recruit, train, and supervise part-time inclusion staff and volunteers
- Monitor and evaluate programming to ensure high-quality participant experiences
- Build strong relationships with participants and families to support engagement and retention
- Foster partnerships with community agencies, schools, and organizations that support inclusive programming
- Assist with departmental planning, administration, and budget coordination
