- Prepares lesson plans for each class, and writing report cards for all lesson participants
- Maintains complete and accurate records of incidents and accidents, swimming occurrences, daily maintenance, opening and closing procedures, and follows up in a timely manner with appropriate action
- Provide first aid care and treatment as required for all minor and major incidents until the arrival of emergency services
- Maintains constant surveillance creating a safe, supervised pool area, vigilant to minimize risks
- Maintains and cleans pool areas, washrooms, changerooms, etc.

Qualifications:

- Must hold a current and valid Lifesaving Society's National Lifeguard Certification AND Instructor certification; certifications must be kept valid throughout employment.
- Valid Standard First Aid & CPR-C/AED Certification.
- Strong understanding and adherence to all legislated requirements, policies and procedures, including emergency procedures and health and safety standards
- Models and practices HIGH FIVE Principles of Healthy Childhood Development
- Ability to pass a Vulnerable Sector Screening through Regional Police.
- Applicants must be at least 15 years of age.
- Experience with various age groups and children with special needs considered a strong asset.
