





1)Do you feel the curriculum is defined in a way to clarify your teaching goals and what you expect your students to learn?

















3) How do you rate the offering of the electives in terms of their relevance to the specialization Streams?





4) How do you rate the electives offered inRelation to the Technological advancements? 488 responses


6) How do you rate the curriculum content you have learnt in relation to your current job and its Compatibility with Industry standards?


