




AIRPORT PRECINCT MAP

AVIATION PRECINCT

The Aviation Precinct provides the core aviation and airside infrastructure to enable a safe, compliant and effective airport.

GATEWAY PRECINCT

The Gateway Precinct will be the primary public access point providing space for the terminal, car parking and a range of commercial uses aligned to the Aviation Precinct.

AEROSPACE PRECINCT

The Aerospace Precinct will accommodate general aviation operations at the Airport, with improved infrastructure and airside access for general aviation businesses to grow and prosper.

AIRPORT NORTH PRECINCT

The Airport North Precinct is ideally located for logistics and freight connectivity. The precinct offers a significant opportunity for related activities including high-quality public domain areas, retail and food/beverage opportunities.

AIRPORT WEST PRECINCT

The Airport West Precinct is an important land parcel within the Airport site with approximately one third of the precinct dedicated to the vegetation corridor and environmental offset areas required under the Sunshine Coast Airport **Expansion Project Environment** Impact Statement approval.
