



AIRSIDE DRIVING AUTHORITY REQUIREMENTS

Prior to sitting the mandatory Airside Driving Authority (ADA) test, the applicant must have completed the following minimum hours as an observer in a vehicle on the Airside;

- 4 hours in relation to an ADA Category 1 or 2. This must include 2 hours as an observer and 2 hours being observed.
- 8 hours (4 hours of which is on the Maneuvering Area) in relation to an ADA Category 2A, 3 or 4. This must include 4 hours as an observer and 4 hours being observed.

***Please Note: Driving test must be done within one month of sitting the written test
This form when complete is to be handed to the SCAPL Safety Officer before the driving test commences***
