- I. Review Your Booking
 Confirmation: Carefully check
 your Booking Confirmation
 documents, which have been
 emailed to you. Ensure that your
 itinerary and personal details
 match your passport information
- 2. Inform Your Travel Agent of Special Requirements: If you have any medical, dietary, or mobility needs, inform your travel agent as soon as possible
- Arrange Travel Insurance: Ensure that you have arranged travel insurance, if you haven't done so already
- 4. Check Visa, Vaccination, and Passport Validity: Verify that your visa(s), vaccinations, and passport are up to date and meet the entry requirements for your destination

- 5. Provide Required Passport and Emergency Contact Details:
 If you haven't already done so, please provide your passport and emergency contact details via your travel agent
- 6. Create Your Cruise Profile: Make sure to update your personal information with the relevant cruise line to create your passenger profile
- 7. Book Excursions and Extras: Consider booking shore excursions, specialty dining, drink packages, and onboard Wi-Fi in advance to enhance your experience
- 8. Plan Travel Logistics: Organise your pre- and post-travel arrangements, such as car parking and airport transfers, for a stress-free journey.

What You'll Need...

Travel Documents:

- · Valid passports for all travellers
- · Cruise tickets and holiday vouchers
- Visa or entry requirements (if applicable)
- · Travel insurance documents
- Necessary medical documents or prescriptions
- Print or save electronic copies of important documents.

Packing Essentials:

- Clothing suitable for the cruise duration and destination
- · Comfortable walking shoes
- Formal attire for any formal nights or special events
- Weather-appropriate clothing (e.g., jackets, hats, sunscreen)

- · Toiletries and personal care items
- Medications

Money & Finances:

- Sufficient cash or credit cards for onboard expenses and shore excursions
- · Currency exchange, if needed
- Be sure to check the local tipping/ gratuity etiquette and requirements

Technology:

- Electrical adapters and chargers for electronic devices
- Consider purchasing an international calling or data plan
- Download essential travel apps (e.g., cruise line and airlines)
