Audition Requirements:

LEVEL 1

Solo piece(s) or etude(s) of your choice. This should be whatever best represents the student's experience level. For Concert Band, the solo(s) or etude(s) can be up to 5 minutes in total length. For Symphonic Band and DSYWE, the solo excerpt must be 2 minutes or less in length.

LEVEL 2

To be considered for the Civic Symphonic Band students must prepare 2 minutes or less of a solo piece (Level 1), **PLUS** the following excerpt:

To be considered for the DSYWE, students must prepare the Level 1 and Level 2 audition requirements, **PLUS** the following excerpts:



- All Auditions should be in AUDIO format (no video). Acceptd takes most file types.
- All Audition materials should be played in ONE video file. This means if your audition materials
 require you to play one or more excerpts or pieces, they should all be recorded back-to-back
 with no editing.
