Ensemble	Audition	Suggested Experience
	Requirements	
Civic Concert Band (CCB)	Level 1 only	1-3 years experience
Civic Symphonic Band (CSB)	Level 1 and 2	2-5 years experience
Civic Philharmonic Orchestra (CPO)	Level 1 and 2	7-12 th grade
Detroit Symphony Youth Wind Ensemble (DSYWE)	Levels 1, 2, and 3	9-12 th grade
Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra (DSYO)	Levels 1, 2, and 3	9-12 th grade

Audition Requirements:

LEVEL 1

Solo piece(s) or etude(s) of your choice. This should be whatever best represents the student's experience level. For Concert Band, the solo(s) or etude(s) can be up to 5 minutes in total length. For Symphonic Band, Philharmonic Orchestra, DSYWE and DSYO, the solo excerpt must be 2 minutes or less in length.

LEVEL 2

To be considered for the Civic Symphonic Band or Civic Philharmonic Orchestra students must prepare 2 minutes or less of a solo piece (Level 1), <u>PLUS</u> the following excerpt:

Sousa The Belle of Chicago Beginning – 4 ^t	th line, 2 nd ending
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LEVEL 3

In order to be considered for the DSYWE or DSYO, students must prepare the Level 1 and Level 2 audition requirements, **PLUS** the following excerpts:

Strauss	Till Eulenspiegels lustige Streiche ("Till	7 measures before 37 – 11 measures
	Eulenspiegel's Merry Pranks"), Op. 28	after 37
Mahler	Symphony 1 in D Major, "Titan"	Mvmt. III. 4 before 3 – 6 after 3

Sousa: The Belle of Chicago (Beginning – 4th line 2nd ending)







LEVEL 3

Strauss: *Till Eulenspiegels lustige Streiche* (*"Till Eulenspiegel's Merry Pranks"*), Op. 28 (7 measures before 37 – 11 measures after 37)



Mahler: Symphony No. 1 in D Major, "Titan" (Mvmt. III: 4 before 3 – 6 after 3)







Recording Instructions

Recording Requirements

- All Auditions should be in AUDIO format (no video). Acceptd takes most file types.
- All Audition materials should be played in ONE video file. This means if your audition materials
 require you to play one or more excerpts or pieces, they should all be recorded back-to-back
 with no editing.
