The position is responsible for serving alcohol to guests during DSO events. Monitors guest consumption of alcoholic beverages as well as their legal age. The chosen candidate will be responsible for the cleanliness of the bar and storage areas.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

Checks ID's and practices safe alcohol service according to state and Max M. Fisher Music Center
policies. • Familiar with all brands of beverages (beer, wine, soda, and liquor) carried by the
establishment • Pours and mixes drinks quickly and accurately • Handles cash readily and with accuracy
• Sets up bar with beverages, garnishes, glasses, and napkins necessary for the event • Returns all items
from the bar to the necessary storage areas at the end of the event • Cleans and organizes bar area and
storage rooms • Performs other activities that contributes to the overall effectiveness of team
management

Position Qualifications:

• Must be 18 years of age • Must have a minimum of 6 months bartending experience and a good knowledge of wine and beer, as well as cocktail recipes. • Must be flexible with hours, long hours standing and/or walking • Must be available to work a minimum of 3 shifts per week including weekends and evenings • Must have taken or willing to take alcohol awareness training • Must be able to exert up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and 25 pounds of force frequently and constantly lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects.
