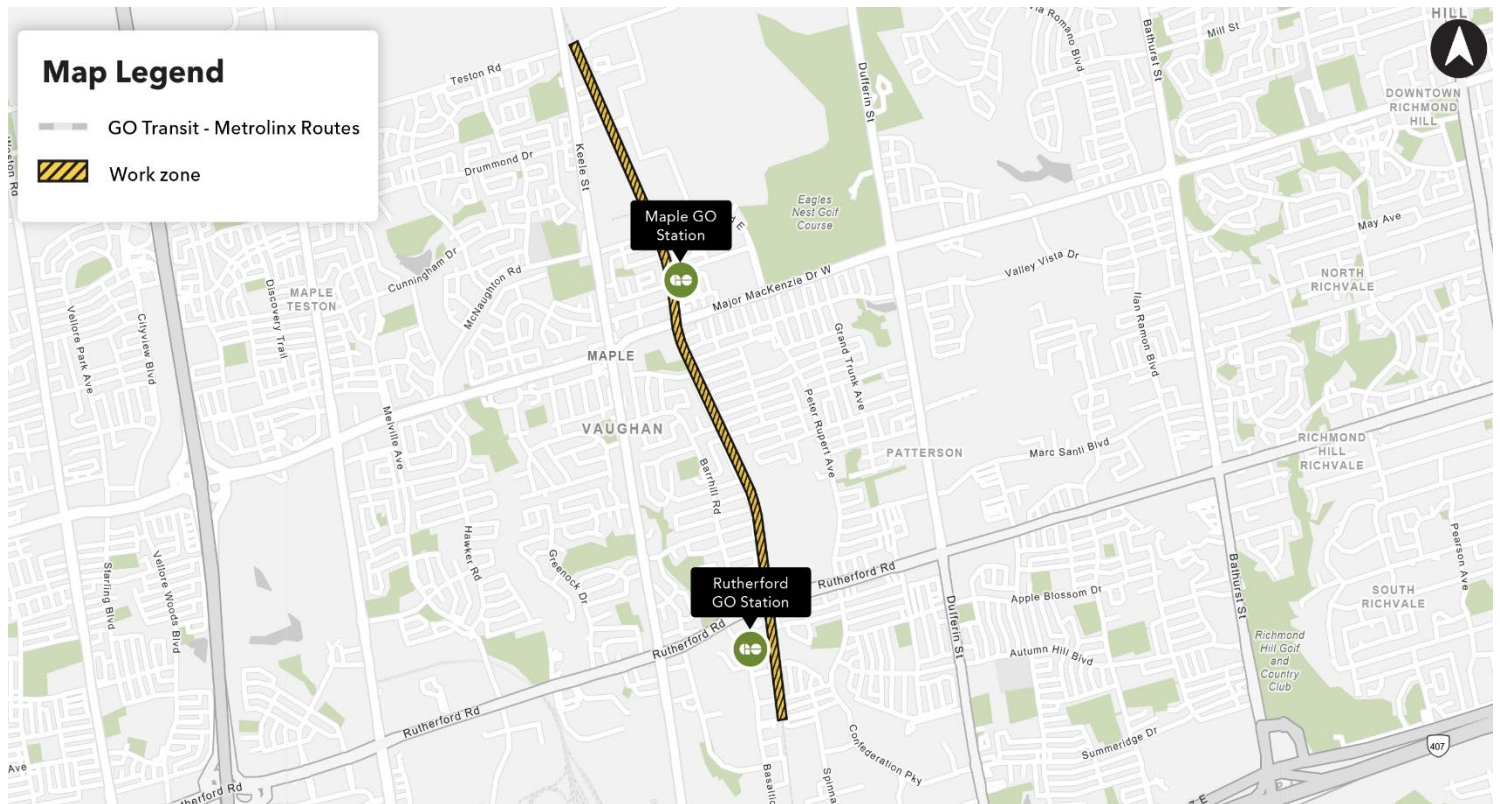


Figure 1: Approximate area of work zones. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

Project Overview

GO Expansion is transforming the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon.

What Is Happening

Metrolinx will be conducting a number of construction activities within the Barrie rail corridor and at Maple GO Station during a weekend service pause (Major Track Closure) of the Barrie line from May 1-4, 2026. This work will occur continuously, day and night, beginning at 11:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1 and ending at 3:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4. Service along the Barrie line will resume on Monday morning after the work has been completed.

These infrastructure improvements are an essential step in bringing increased service to the line. By carrying them out over a weekend MTC, our crews are able to work on the tracks safely and without interruption from live trains. We understand that night works are not ideal and will do our best to mitigate any impacts to the surrounding communities.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be conducting a number of works including:
 - Shave and pave of the Maple GO parking lot
 - Asphaltting a section of the east platform
 - Line painting at the station
 - Construction fence removal at the station
 - Switch relocation (in-corridor)
 - Installation of a radio tower antenna (in-corridor) and removal of a radio tower
 - Retaining wall improvements (in-corridor)
- Please note that many of these works have already been ongoing and were previously communicated.
- Crews will use different equipment including excavators, pavers, rollers and various trucks.
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with these activities.
- Lights will be directed towards the work sites to minimize any light pollution to the area.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur continuously, day and night, starting at 11:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1, 2026 and will be completed by 3:00 a.m. on Monday, May 4, 2026.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur at Maple GO Station and within the Barrie corridor (see Figure 1).

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no pedestrian impacts.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are no traffic impacts.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- This work will occur during a weekend pause in service of the Barrie line from May 1-4.
- A portion of the parking lot will be unavailable for customer use during the weekend work.
- The parking spots will be opened again when Barrie GO service resumes on the morning of Monday, May 4, 2026.
