

Aurora GO: Weekend continuous works

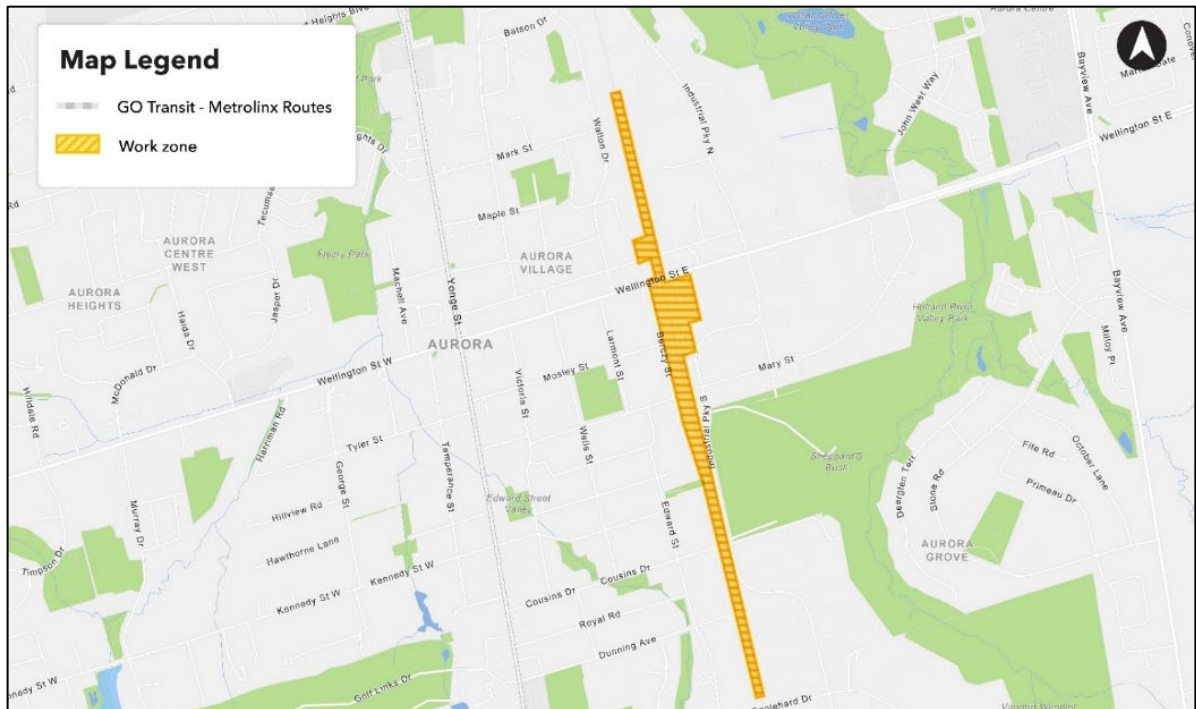


Figure 1: Approximate area of work zone. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

Project Overview

GO Expansion is transforming the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon.

What Is Happening

To support station improvements at Aurora GO, Metrolinx will be installing track panels throughout the May 22-25 weekend. Crews will be within the corridor conducting grading and surfacing. The track work will require a single lane closure of Centre Street, north of Aurora GO station. The lane closure will be intermittent, and traffic flow in both directions will be maintained during the work.

These activities are being done during a weekend pause of the Barrie line to allow for crews to safely work on the track. We understand that overnight work is not ideal and will take all measures to minimize the disruptiveness of the works to the surrounding community.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be installing track panels.
- Equipment to be used include various trucks, excavators, and track equipment.
- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work. No significant noise levels are expected to be reached, and vibration monitors will also be in place as needed, depending on the work activities.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur continuously between 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 22 and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, May 25, 2026.
- We understand that overnight work is not ideal and will make every effort to mitigate impacts to the surrounding community during this important work.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will take place within the rail corridor (see Figure 1).

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Sidewalks will be accessible for the duration of closure. We kindly ask all pedestrians to remain alert for trucks entering and exiting the work area and to follow all instructions provided by traffic control personnel.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be an intermittent, single-lane closure along Centre Street for the duration of this work to maintain an access point to the work site for the transport of equipment and materials.
- A traffic management plan will be in place to manage the flow of drivers and maintain traffic flow in both directions.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- During this major track closure, service along the Barrie line will be paused. Local transit will be rerouted. Please visit the York Region Transit website for more details.

- We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we strive to bring you enhancements at Aurora GO station.
