

King City GO: Weekend works

May 1-4, May 22-25, and May 29-June 1, 2026*

From 11:00 p.m. on Friday until 3:00 a.m. on Monday (continuous)

*Date is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

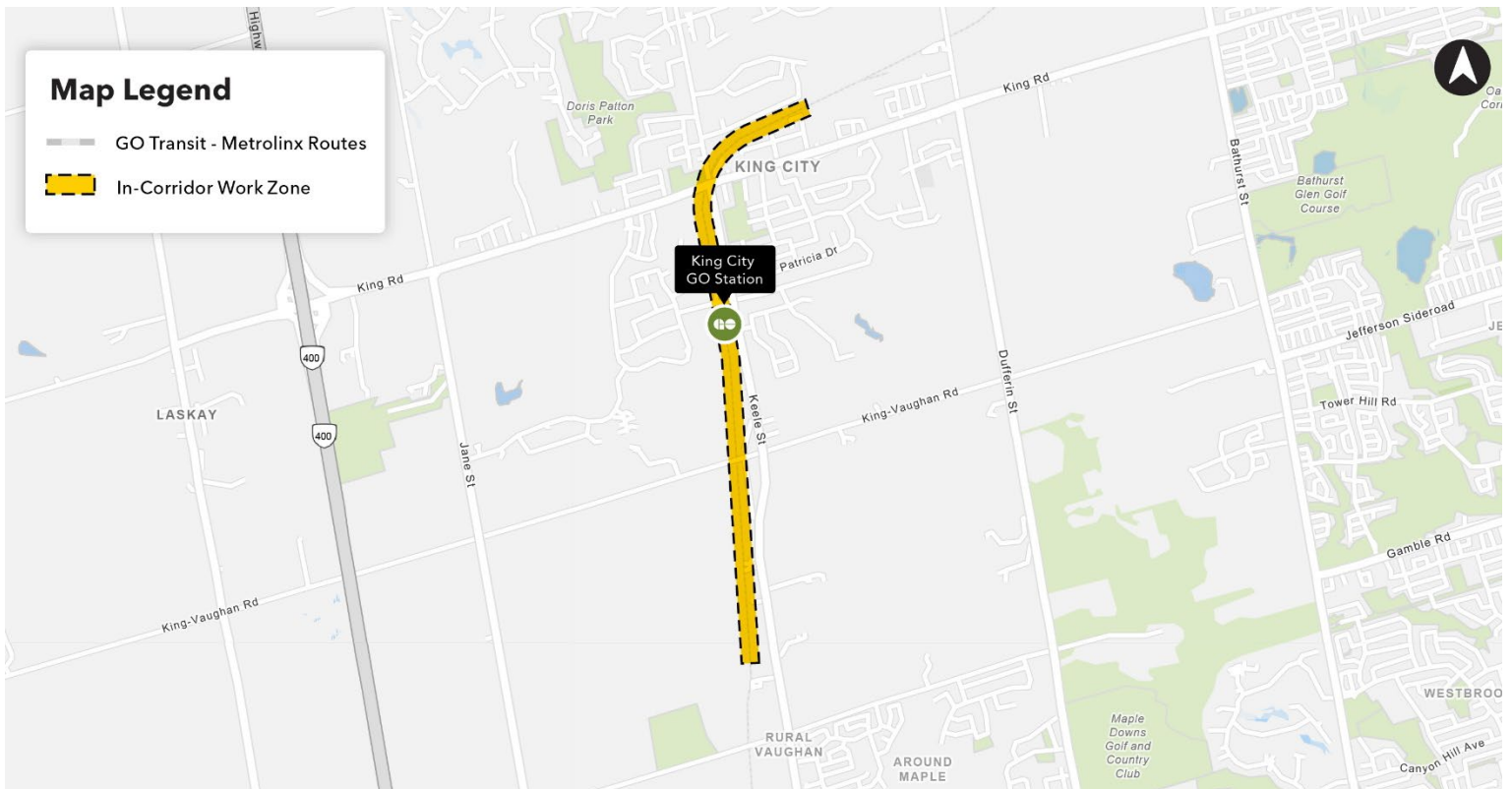


Figure 1: Approximate area of in-corridor and station works. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

Project Overview

GO Expansion is transforming the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon.

What Is Happening

Metrolinx will be conducting a number of construction activities within the Barrie rail corridor and at King City GO station during three weekend service pauses (Major Track Closures/MTCs) of the Barrie line on the following dates:

- **May 1-4, 2026**
- **May 22-25, 2026**
- **May 29 - June 1, 2026**

This work will occur continuously, day and night, beginning at 11:00 p.m. each Friday and ending at 3:00 a.m. each Monday. Service along the Barrie line will resume on Monday morning after the work has been completed.

These infrastructure improvements are an essential step in bringing increased service to the line. By carrying them out over a weekend MTC, our crews can work on the tracks safely and without interruption from live trains. We understand that night work is not ideal, and we will do our best to mitigate any impacts on the surrounding communities.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be conducting several works including:
 - Open cut work for a steel pipe installation (only on the May 1-4 weekend)
 - Noise wall construction activities
 - Installation of high-security fencing
 - Grading and excavations
 - Platform construction works at the station
- Please note that these works have already been ongoing and were communicated in previous notices.
- Crews will use different equipment including excavators, pavers, rollers and various trucks.
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with these activities.
- Lights will be directed towards the work sites to minimize any light pollution to the area.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur continuously, day and night, starting at 11:00 p.m. on the Friday of each weekend and will be completed by 3:00 a.m. on each Monday.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur within the Barrie rail corridor and at King City GO station (see Figure 1).

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no pedestrian impacts.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are no traffic impacts.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- This work will occur over three weekend pauses in service of the Barrie line in May.
- Barrie GO service will resume each Monday morning.
- Please visit the GO Transit website for information about alternative travel options.

- We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we strive to bring you enhancements at King City GO station.
