

Important Tips and Maintenance






Keep children and animals away from working area as smaller parts may cause choking if swallowed.



Never place liquids or anything damp upon furniture as it will mark. Ensure a coaster or running is beneath.



Never use ammonia based cleaning products as it will damage the finish.




To avoid fading, keep furniture out of direct sunlight.





Use a soft or damp cloth(dry cloth)when wiping or cleaning surfaces.

Lay a soft matt down to protect the furniture piece before and during assembly.

So your relationship is strong.But is it flat-pack furniture strong? Unless you're an aerospace engineer, assembling furniture can be slightly stressful.We recommend meditating quietly, pouring yourself a herbal tea (or slightly less herbal wine) and tackling things one step at a time.If you feel a passive aggressive remark coming on, try a compliment instead.E.g. This 7-step assembly should take around 1 hour with an Allen Key - or 30 minutes with and electric drill. Godspeed.



Tips Before Your Start:


- Remove all wrapping material, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble.
- DO NOT tighten all screws and bolts until completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.

QUICKFIT



Tighten quickfit until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten.


CAM LOCK



When fitting cam lock, ensure starting position is correct before you insert connecting quickfit.

Quickfit head should be in the centre of the cam lock when the two panels are joined.

Cam lock should be inserted before quickfit.



Turn cam lock clockwise to tighten.










