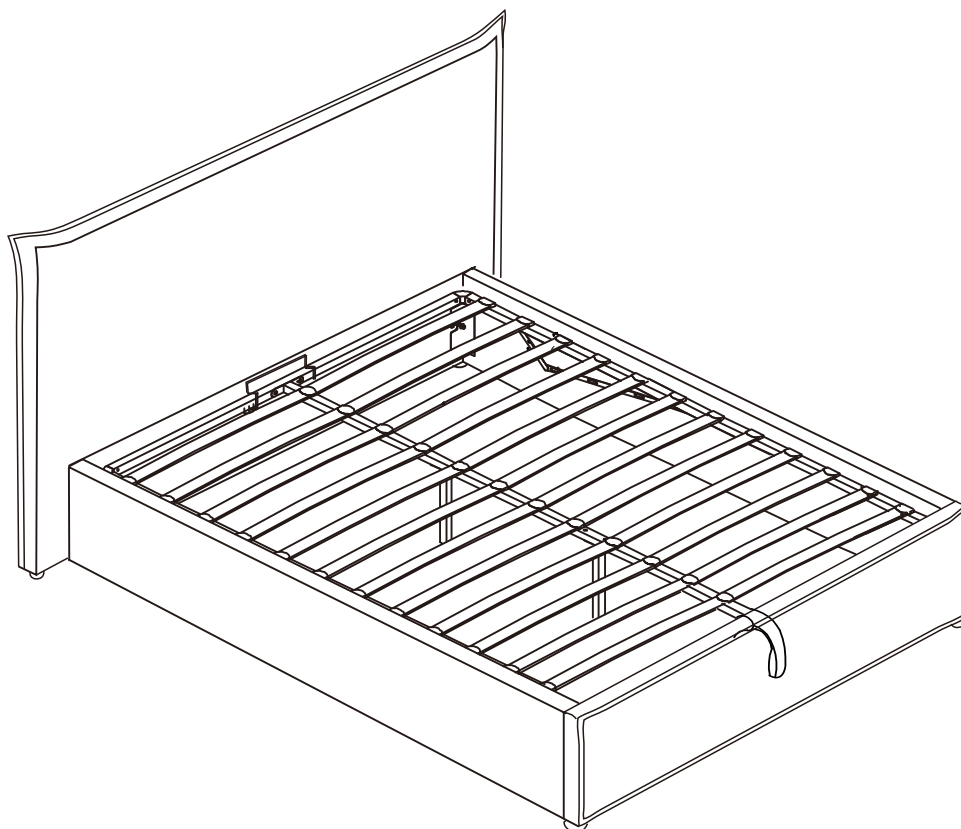


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

Maintenance:

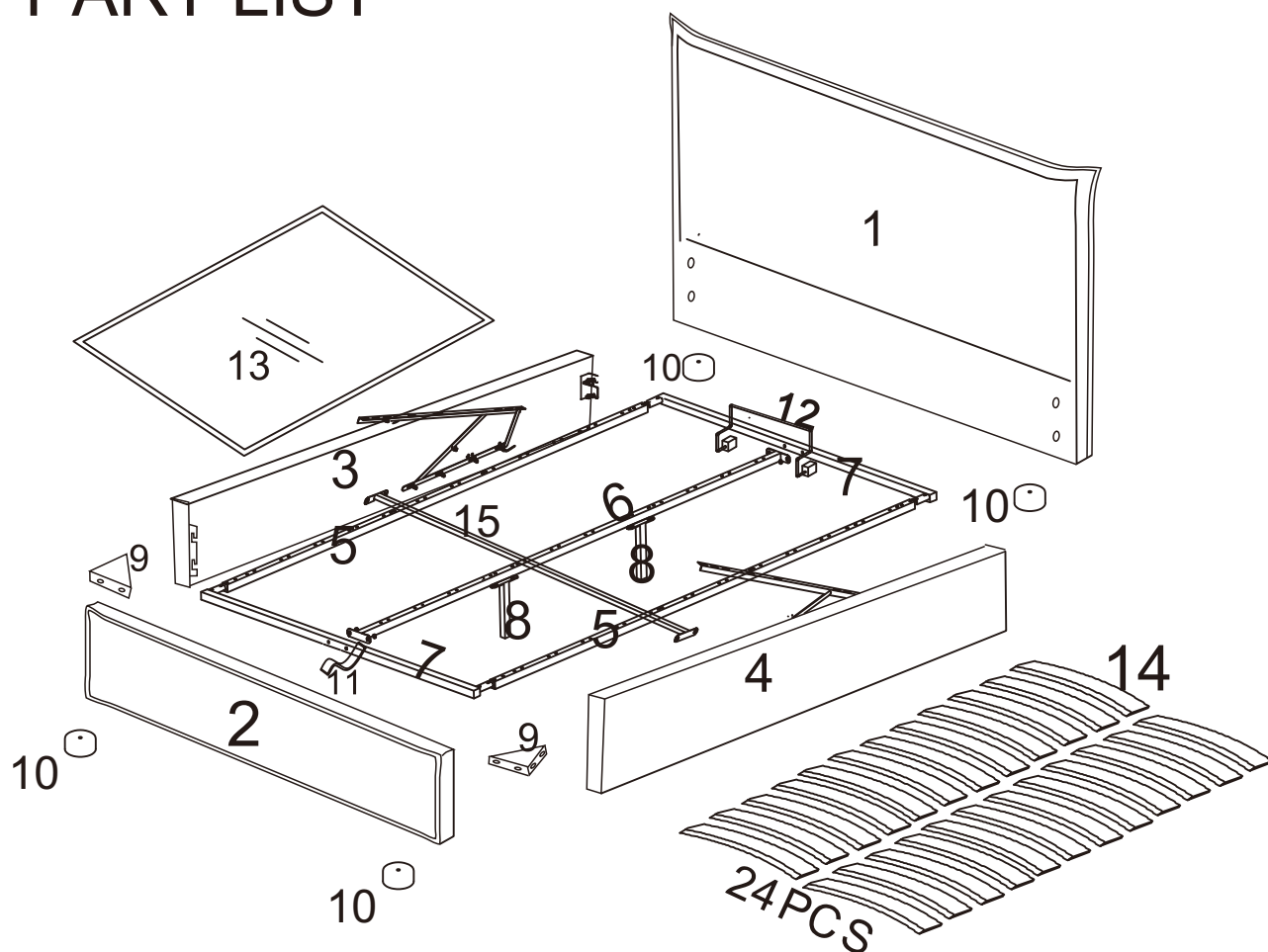
Over time, and depending on how often the product is used, some fittings may loosen slightly. This is completely normal for flat-pack furniture. Simply check and **tighten any fixings** from time to time to keep everything secure.

Cleaning & Care:

- Wipe with a **damp (not wet)** cloth.
 - Use a **dry duster** or **standard furniture polish** for regular cleaning.-
- Avoid using abrasive or chemical cleaners.

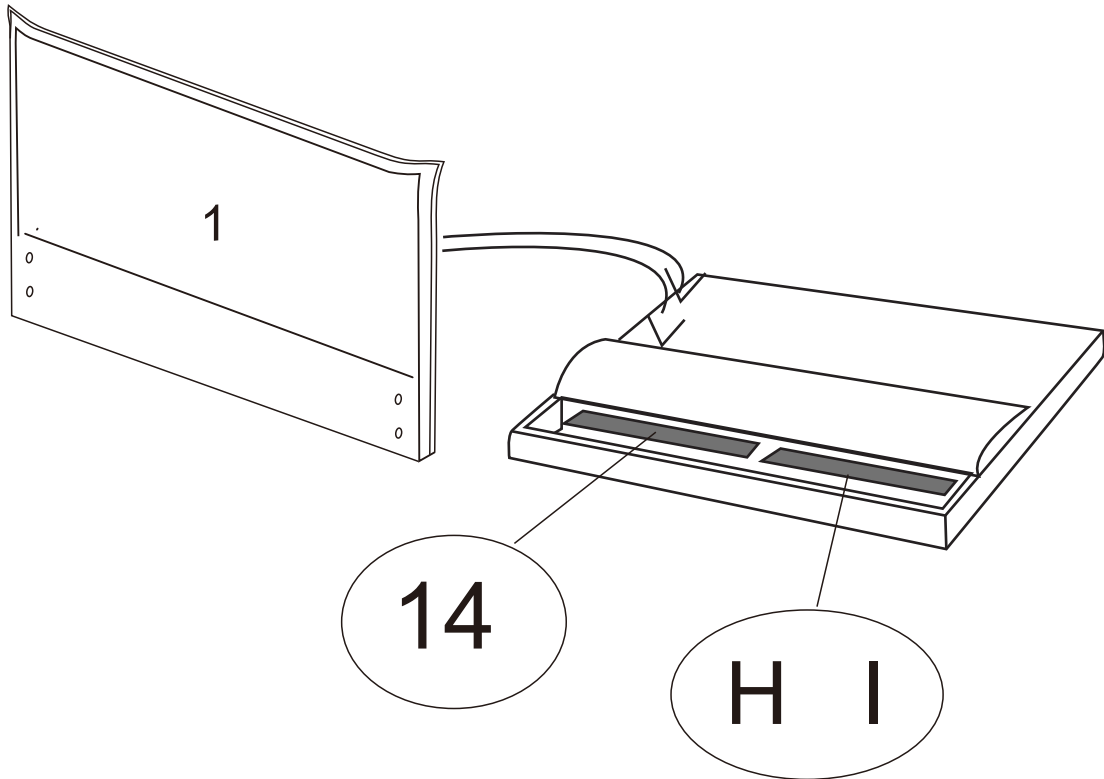

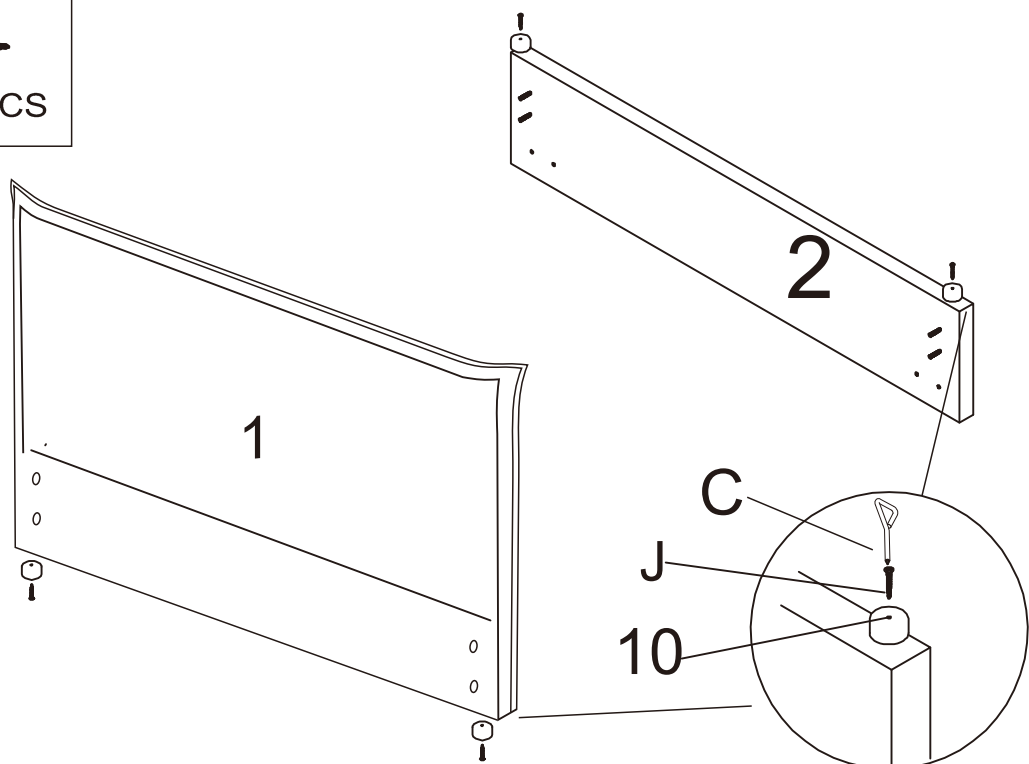
STEP 1

The bed slats (14) and plastic caps (H & I) are in the back of the headboard. Please take them out before you assemble the bed.

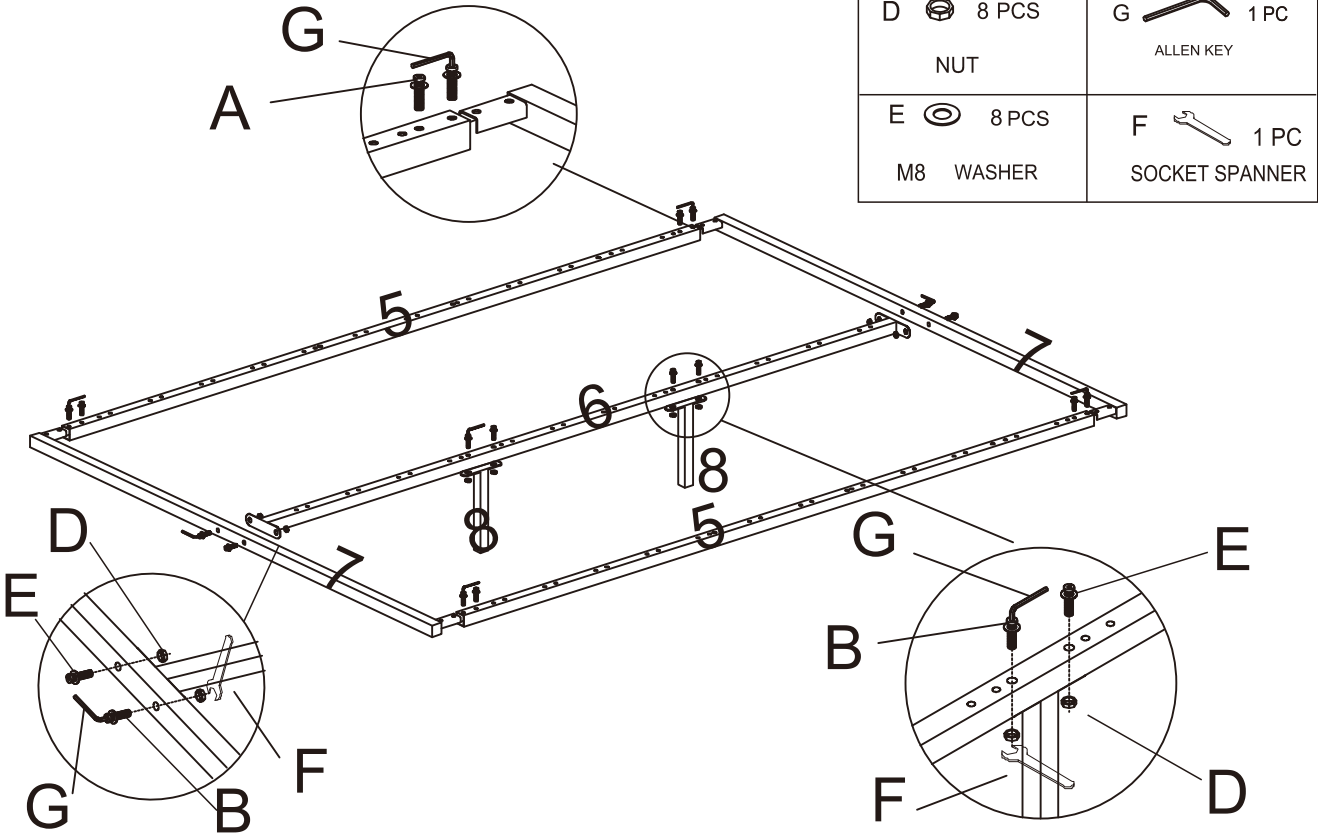

F  1 PC SOCKET SPANNER	

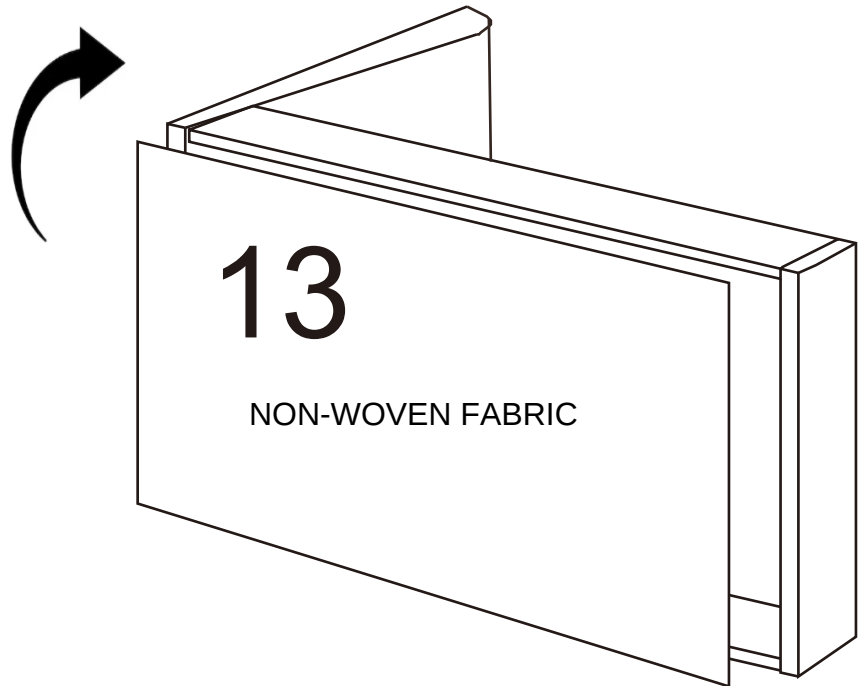


STEP 7

Carefully turn the bed frame over so the bottom side is facing up.

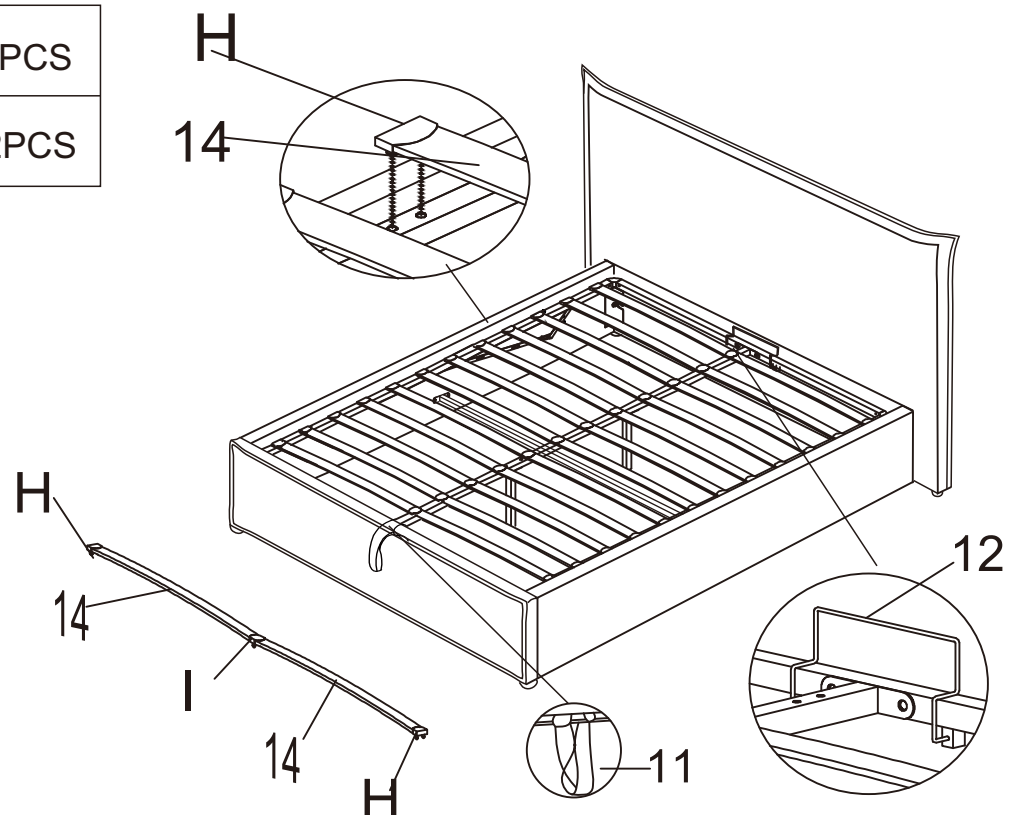
Attach the non-woven fabric (Part 13) to the bottom of the bed frame.
