





Visits and Diagnoses



After being low during the covid years (2020-2021), the number of patients and visits started to back to normal in 2022.






Visits By Age



The DOTS Strategy for controlling TB and Leprosy

ASRI's Directly Observed Treatment Short-course (DOTS) ensure that every tuberculosis (TB) patient takes regular doses of their medication. In 2022, 10 DOTS workers and 1 DOTS Coodrinator helped 84 TB patients and 11 leprosy patients.





Mobile Clinic

Mobile Clinic provides medical services to patients in remote areas. Monthly, ASRI's Mobile Clinic visited Jihing sub-villages in Kayong Utara District.














Top Ten Diagnoses



RESEARCH AND DATABASE

- Analyzing deforestation using satellite imagery for a COVID-19 resilience study, the results showed that both before and during the pandemic, deforestation rates and other activities that damage nature decreased. Furthermore, communities in ASRI's working areas were more economically and ecologically resilient before and during the pandemic.
 Deforestation rates in ASRI's working areas were always lower than in other areas, and despite having access to rich natural resources, communities did not choose unsustainable occupations.
- In 2021 2022 conduct a socio-economic survey. The results were monthly income, organic farmers and MSMEs did not increase significantly after the training, but they feel more prosperous.
- The analysis of soil erosion in the National Park area has been completed with the results that the erosion-prone areas are centered in the east of TNGP and there is a slight increase in erosion levels at several points from 2009 to 2020
