Suitable for 10+ neighbours

How it works

- 1. Get your neighbours together and agree a date and location for the clothes swap
- 2. Make sure you agree guidelines, with conditions around cleanliness and condition and whether shoes and accessories can be included
- 3. Swap! Bring your unwanted clothes and get some new ones in return. Donate any leftovers to a local charity shop.

Make sure you take some photos of the swap - and share them across your community.
