## How it works

- 1. Get your neighbours together and agree a date and location to clean up your community
- 2. On the day, pick up litter and fly-tipping and make natural areas beautiful again
- 3. Arrange collection of the rubbish at gov.uk/find-local-council or by taking it to your local recycling centre.

Make sure you take some photos of the clean up – and share them across your community.

- Litter pickers
- Protective gloves
- Bin bags
- Container for sharp objects
