#### How Prairie Bowmen Began

On February 26, 1954 Jim Lund and other local archers called a meeting at the YMCA downtown to form The Prairie Bowmen of Lincoln. The vote was favorable and a constitution was adopted. It was the first "field archery club" in Nebraska as several of the archers were familiar with the N.F.A.A. protocols and wished to pursue field competitions. Officers elected at that time were Bob Ellis—President, Don Hintz –Vice President, and Jim Lund—Secretary. Jim Lund set up a target event in Antelope Park the next Sunday in which 17 members participated.

A month later at the March meeting a field course site had been offered for use by the Skyline Dairy owned by State Senator Otto Liebers. That site is our present location of the club. Three more board members were added at that time being Jack Swiggard---Range Master, Dick Koch, and Lyle Young. The Prairie Bowmen became a chartered affiliate of the NFAA at this time and adopted its policies, practices, and procedures

The energetic club members established a regulation field range and target facilities quickly to get the club started. At the same time this group of archers set about to improve hunting opportunities in Nebraska by working with other conservation groups and legislative bodies. The primary objectives identified for this club were the recreational sport in competition with each other and also to satisfy man's inherent nature to pursue wild life in such a manner as to provide it controlled existence consistent with present and future times.





#### New Targets

If you have been to the indoor range lately you will see that lanes 5-14 now have brand new Bulldog<sup>TM</sup> targets. The Spyder Web<sup>TM</sup> targets were moved to lanes 1-4, 15-16, and two roll-a-round bales. The only remaining target bales with fiberboard is on Lanes A-D and E-G.

The targets are <u>very</u> stiff so use caution when pulling your arrows so you don't pull out a tip or break an arrow. The plastic target pins are not compatible with the Bulldogs, so there are metal pins available for your convenience.

The work crew also cleaned the area behind the targets. This will make it easier and safer to find the occasional missing arrow.

The board thanks everybody who sacrificed a Saturday to improve the indoor range. We also need to give a big thanks to Kurtzer Brothers Refuse for hauling away the old fiberboard.
