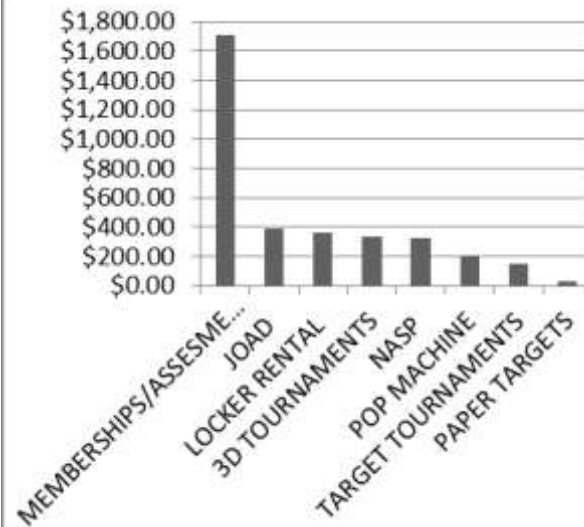

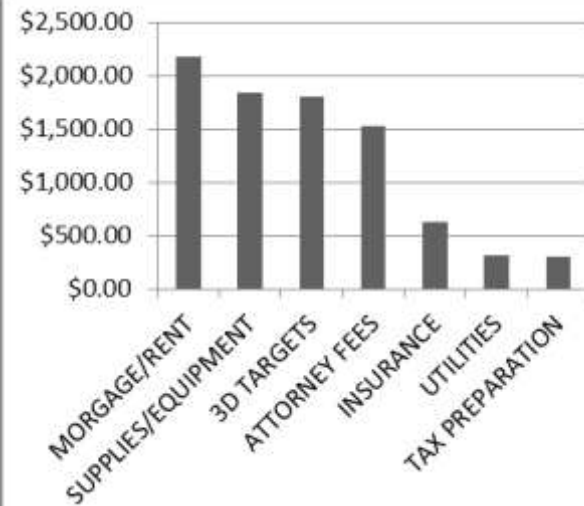

Minutes of May 19, 2013 Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 6:11 PM at the outdoor range. Jim Tubbs and Mike Yost absent.

Minutes read and 3 changes noted and made changes to minutes. Minutes approved with changes.

Jim's target report: His email read as to why absent and read by John. Funeral in family and Iron Archer June 2 with a workday on June 1. Mass email requested. A 20 target 3D needs to be set up in bottom and butts moved on American range. Also needs a \$100 bank and money bag. A check for food and will turn in receipts.

Bowhunter report by Adam: 19 shooters with \$300. Good coarse and had 5 people help set up. State Games on July 25 and to get with Tom Nauman if see if his assistance is needed. Hired on by the BNSF and starts days June 3 so will be able to attend meetings.

Secretary Report by John. One new member with Kory Reiman, family membership from JOAD. Member approved.

Youth Report: No report. Mike is starting the Saturday morning on June 1.

Website report Josh Hesson: Not much to report. Changes are being made to template to make it easier.

Newsletter report by Michael Welsh. Newsletter went out and got a few back. Club contact list updated by John. John read drop list with 265.

New Business

1. Newsletter hard copy: Motion made to have it out every other month. Seconded and approved. Months need to be fixed in by-laws.
2. Range Maintenance: Try to do a workday once a month. Tree needs to be cut up yet.
3. Member Notice: Discussed as to how many notices are sent out and what could be done with less notices. Three bills are sent out and 2 post cards.
4. Pager number: Number that is used for contact discussed.
5. Post Office Box. Discussion on if we should get a PO Box and address at indoor range good. How to get mail there talked about. Trent going to check on PO Box and box for mail.
6. Boosalis Maintenance. No contract yet. Long discussion with pros and cons presented. Trent talking with the NRD about a place to have an outdoor range. Maintenance will continue at the Helen Boosalis Archery Range but will not be under Prairie Bowmen's name. Motion made to discontinue support at the Helen Boosalis Archery Range. Seconded and passed with one no vote (John Elliott).

7. Assistants: Discussion about assistance and how to handle. Mike made a proposal in writing about assistants. Limited to two people, subject to Board approval. Keys for needed areas only, must be PB members for 4 months, reduced or free membership at board's discretion. Helpers: limited to two people, not subject to board approval, does not have to be PB member, and is not given access to keys, reduced membership as per approval. Motion made and seconded. Passed with one no vote of John Elliott.
8. Prairie Bowmen Inventory at Boosalis: Inventory to be taken and returned to PB. (Done)
9. Youth Bank Account: What is it used for? Discussion followed. It was supposed to have any money that was to be used or came in from sponsored in that account. Talked about using Quick Books to separate youth money from general fund. Tabled till next month.
10. New 3D inserts: 15 inserts found in outdoor freezer. No one knew how they got there and why. Adam donating a small freezer for indoor range.
11. Audit Report: Most of receipts got destroyed in water in Cindie's basement according to her. More detailed report needed after every shoot broke down as to how many shot, food, cost of shoot etc.
12. Hot Water Heater: Water heater not working. Needs a new heater core.
13. Mowers: John Deere won't start. Needs battery and starter. Fixed. Craftsman needs a battery charger. Motion made to purchase, seconded. Passed.
14. 3D Targets: White Rock Archery club selling out there stock of 3D targets. Wanted to use this years and next year's budget and buy \$3100 to \$3600 dollars worth of 3D's. Discussion on buying the targets and how we can pay for them at this time. Adam and Trent to go look at and check the condition of targets. Motion made to spend this year's budget of \$1800.
15. Adverse Settlement: Discussion on what was sent to Trent. Wayne Janssen said that none of what Trent was saying was on the agreement. The way it was written was all in Collingworth's favor and just not going to do anything that good for the club. Wes explained to the board how all this got started as to the Adverse Position and the \$5000 that was allocated for the lawyer. We have spent just over \$4700. Wayne had made a lot of notes on the agreement to make it work for the club. Motion made to have Wayne take the changes to the lawyer and have him draw up a new agreement PB can live you. Seconded. Passed. We can take the barricade down and drive in from the housing area if we want to drive in the mud.
16. Canopy: Paul wants to use the canopy. Put down deposit for damage but no rent. Will accept donation for use.
17. Chris Benson asked if he could show the County Assessor the property if he asks to see it. OK'd

Adjourned meeting at 8:29PM. Next meeting at the outdoor range June 17th.

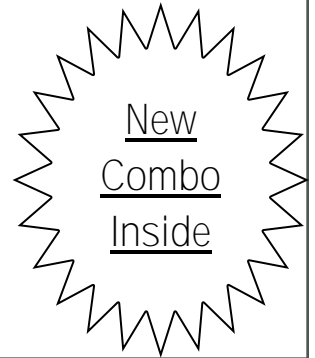
