Target Report

We had a great time with the Spring Target League. The mix format was very popular as it gave everyone a different style each week.

The Target League did open up some discussion about what targets and distances we should setup in the upper and lower range. Currently we have a mix of FHA targets with bricks setting the distance. The paint of the bricks is getting hard to see and some of the distances they are set at are not correct.

It has been suggested that the paths should covered in wood chips. This will lower the amount that needs to be mowed and would make the trails less muddy after the rains. It would also cover the bricks and make them unusable. Several people have told me they don't use the bricks anyway and either use a range finder or just mentally calculate the distance.

So I am wanting to find out from our members how they would like to see the field course setup.

- Leave it the way it is and repaint the bricks;
- Cover with wood chips and set posts with distance;
- All animal targets or a mix of Field and hunter;
- Other options;

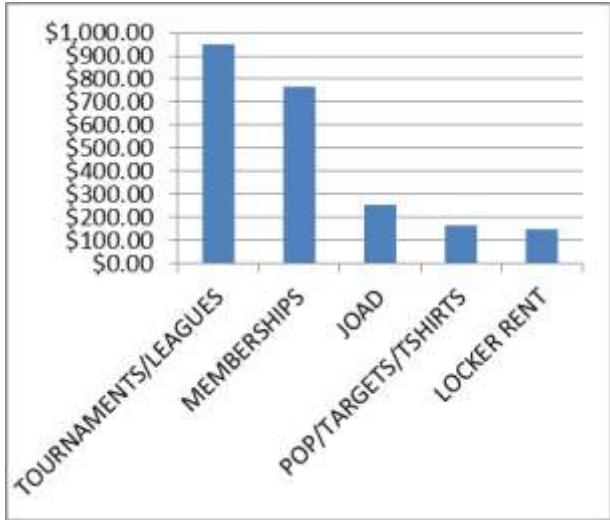

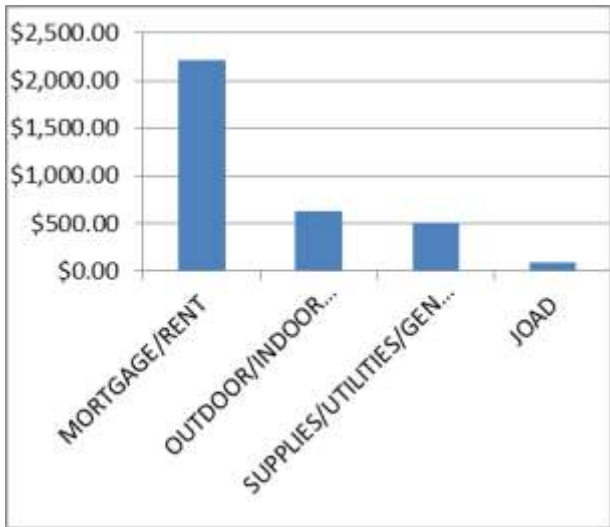

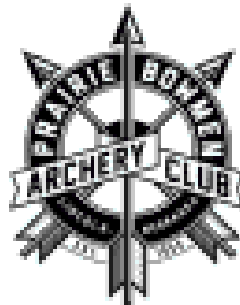
