

Election Time

Board positions up for election this year are *President, Secretary/Treasurer, Bowhunting Coordinator, and Education/Youth Coordinator.* These are all two year terms.

Board members shall not hold a leadership position in a competing organization.

Board members shall participate in a minimum of three work days and shall shoot or help run two club events per year.

Board members are responsible for tracking club property under their areas. Each board member shall submit an inventory list to the President before the Budget Committee meets.

Board members must be a club member in good standing for a minimum of four months.

Board members will receive a free membership.

Board members are expected to attend all board meetings.

Board members shall promote all club functions and try to attend all club functions when possible.

If you are interested in running for one of these positions you will need to attend the Board Meeting, September 185th at the Outdoor Range at 7PM. At this time you will need to present a biography to be published in the October newsletter. The ballots for the election will also go out in the October newsletter and will be opened at the Annual Board Meeting, October 20th. The winners will be announced at that meeting and published in the November newsletter. They shall attend the November Board of Directors meeting and they will assume their office at the end of the December Board Meeting.
