# SECRETARY /TREASURER REPORT

## Secretary's Report

The 6/27/2019 meeting was called to order at 7:00. Board members present were: Jim Tubbs, Brian Krogman, Chase Powers, Adam Jirovsky, Steve Woitaszewski, Wayne Janssen and Chris Benson. Also present was Danny Tubbs.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Indoor leagues have ended, they averaged 8-9 shooters per week. The State 900 will be at our outdoor range this weekend on June 30<sup>th</sup>. The range will be closed for the weekend for work day and the shoot.

Bowhunter: The Scheel's shoot went well, approximately 120-125 shooters total with about 100 adults. There were many positive comments about the shoot.

The 3-D targets have been organized and stored in the garage. We need to order several inserts and Chase would like to order 2-3 new critters to keep interest in our shoots.

Youth: Home schoolers had a day at the indoor range yesterday (June 26) with 21 kids ages 8 and up participating. The next session of classes will be starting on July 9<sup>th</sup>. So far only 4 kids have signed up to attend our proposed Kids Camp.

Range Master: Plans are to spray the lower range and fog around the clubhouse for mosquitos before this Sunday's State 900. Targets need to be moved and the American range mowed before Sunday. There is a work day scheduled for Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>.

Communication: Posters are current, a last notice for Kid's Camp will be posted soon. There has been an issue with our website recently and will be checked into.

Old business: Matt Carmin will be here July 5-6 to teach level 1 & 2 USA Archery instructors.

The 3 3-D targets lent to Dudley Sorenson have been returned. They were used in a fund raiser for the Wounded Warrior project.

The garage roof is "on the board" for Apple roofing. They have been very busy lately with storm damage work.

New Business: Danny Tubbs requested reinstatement to the club. After discussion the board voted to reinstate.

New member applications from Josey VanOrsdale (Family), Caleb Frew (Single), Erik Prenosil (Family) and Ben Keller (Scheels) were presented and approved.

Bowhunter: Chase reported a need for 3-D inserts for our August jamboree. It was moved and seconded to allow Chase to spend up to \$1,000 for inserts and 3-D targets. Motion carried. The Jamboree is August 17 & 18 with the State marked 3-D also the 18<sup>th</sup>.

Youth: Steve said 8 new people are shooting in the current class. Pretty good turnout considering the very hot weather lately.

Rangemaster: The roof was replaced on one of the picnic shelters the last work day. The second one will need to be done at a later date. The next work day is scheduled for August 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 am at the outdoor range.

Communication: Wayne reported that all notices have been dealt with to date. Notices for the Jamboree and work day will be coming soon.

Old Business: Steve, Harry and Jim have been certified as level 2 instructors for USA Archery so we can again teach JOAD classes.
