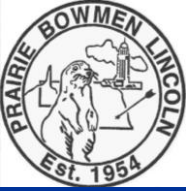

Secretary/Treasurer Report by Chris Benson

The 2/19/2020 Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm at the indoor range.

Board members present were: Jim Tubbs, Steve Woitaszewski, Brian Krogman, Chad Morgan, Bob Larsen, Danny Tubbs, and Chris Benson.

Club members present were: Wayne Janssen, Harry Windle, John Filsinger, and David Wolfe.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Chad reported the President's Day shoot had 39 shooters, pretty good turnout considering the weather. The first target league was Monday (2/17/20) with 7 shooters. The next club shoot scheduled is the 900 round in July.

We have our first target lane sponsor, Blue River Archery. More are expected.

Bowhunter: Danny reported the Bowhunter league will start Thursday (2/20/20). There is a 3-D shoot scheduled for the end of the month, (2/29/20-3/1/20). This will consist of 20 targets, two arrows each, the fee will be \$15. The range will be closed to open shooting on that Saturday around 11:00am until Sunday around 6:00pm.

Youth: Steve reported an informal class will start next Tuesday (2/23/20) and go for 7 weeks. The classes scheduled through SCC start on April 14.

Rangemaster: Brian reports the new indoor range is basically done.

Correspondence: Bob reported he is down to one bad email. Twelve new member applications have been sent in electronically. The club is moving toward having all member applications, dues payments, etc. handled on line. This should eliminate the problem we've had for years with incorrect email addresses, etc.

Old Business: Shooting lane sponsorships are available. Blue River Archery has purchased one, the Big Game Conservation Association plans to purchase one, and others have expressed interest.

Jim has met with Alan from American Electronics and signed a 5year contract for the entrance door for \$25 per month.

Tony at Adams Auto Repair has graciously allowed us to tie into his internet service for no charge. This is saving the club about \$110 per month. The internet is necessary to operate the door system.

The contract to sell the outdoor range has been signed with two addendums. One includes the outlet off Galloway Circle in the sale, the other gives us until July 30 to remove club personal property.

Matt McKee from "Here's Your Sign" is taking care of signage for our door and front windows.

New Business: The indoor range has passed final inspection by Building and Safety and an occupancy permit has been issued. The new range has been leased for 5 years.

The Lincoln Chapter of the Big Game Conservation Association is holding a recruitment night at the indoor range on April 15th. They will supply snacks and refreshments. This should be a good night for recruitment of new members to our club.

Our annual Banquet is scheduled for April 4th at the indoor range. More information to follow.

There was discussion regarding trying to work out some type of agreement with Game and Parks for our members to use their outdoor range.

Our new website seems to be working well. All membership is now online. The new facebook address is: Prairie Bowmen Archery - Lincoln.

We have had about 60-70 members get their door codes so far.

There was discussion regarding some type of "head to head" competition for the NASP school teams in town. This is being tentatively scheduled for April 4th.
