The 3/25/2020 Board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by vice-president Chad Morgan at the indoor range.

Board members present were: Chad Morgan, Bob Larsen, Brian Krogman, Steve Woitaszewski, Danny Tubbs and Chris Benson.

Club members present were: John Filsinger and Harry Windle.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Chad reported the leagues have been averaging 8-10 people. Monday, March 28th is the last night of the current session. Plans are to continue the league into and through the summer months depending on participation.

The State Indoor 300 Round was held at our range on March 13th & 14th. There were 52 shooters which was a good turnout and nice financial boost for our club.

Bowhunter: Danny reported the 3-D league is averaging 21-26 shooters. That will be ending now with the coronavirus restrictions. Our invitational 3-D shoot on 2/29 and 3/1 had 44 shooters.

Youth: Steve reported the planned classes through Southeast Community College have been cancelled. His current class consists of a single shooter and a family of 5 so that class will continue. The next scheduled class session will be postponed until July pending the coronavirus situation.

Rangemaster: Brian plans to move the target stands at the outdoor range so they can't be used after the sale of the range is completed. It is time to plan how we're going to get the club personal property removed from the range.

Correspondence: Bob reported the website has been updated to include the age requirements for family membership. The board members also discussed our gratitude to member Patrick Sullivan for his invaluable work in creating our new website. His help is greatly appreciated.

Old Business: "Here's Your Sign" has placed the club logo and name on the door and windows. Plans are to add color to the windows.

The planned recruitment night with the Big Game Conservation Association has been cancelled.

Over 100 door codes have been issued so far.

Discussion was held regarding forming a committee to look at changes to the club bylaws, club rules and welcome to the club information.

New Business: The club banquet planned for April 4th and the Celebration of Life for Carol Elliott scheduled for April 19 will be postponed due to the coronavirus restrictions.

Nebraska Game & Parks is interested in purchasing target stands from our outdoor range. Suggestion is \$100 each. It was moved and seconded to proceed with the sale.
