#### Youth Education Report by Steve Woitaszewski





- Lockers are available for rent for \$50.00 per year.
- Paper targets are available for 50 cents (put money in mail slot by office door
  - Everyone is responsible for cleaning up after themselves

\*No illegal or controlled substances

\*No firearms of any kind

\*Crossbows only to be shot a crossbow target

#### \*No broadheads of any kind to be shot at any of the targets

\* No outsert tips to be shot at any targets

\*Anything that shoots a projectile other than archery equipment is prohibited

\*Always make sure that knocked arrows are pointed down range

\*No unattended children (an adult must accompany children under 16)

\*No horseplay or unauthorized games

\*No pets

Please make sure that lights are off, heat turned down and door locked, if you are the last one to leave.
