Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved followed by the Treasurer's report.

Bowhunter: No report. The corona virus has the leagues shut down at this time.

Youth: Steve reported the 5 people in the class are continuing, (4 are in one family). July 21st is the scheduled start for the next session.

Rangemaster: Brian has moved the target stands to the parking lot to prevent usage. A couple of crossbow targets have been installed at the indoor range.

Target: Chad reported 5-6 shooters are continuing to shoot on league night.

New business: The Nebraska Game & Parks Commission is planning to purchase some of our target stands.

Discussion was held regarding what to do with the proceeds from the sale of the outdoor range. The two basic options are regular CD's or an ICS (Insured Cash Sweep) account at Cornhusker Bank. With the latter, the entire amount will be insured by the FDIC and the funds are completely liquid for our access at any time. It was moved and seconded to place the funds in the ICS account at Cornhusker Bank. The motion was approved unanimously.

New member applications were reviewed and approved for: the Matt Winternheimer family, William Van Setten II family, Ben Woods, Ethan Anderson and Elizabeth Clinger.

The next meeting is scheduled for 12:00 noon on May 16 at the outdoor range.
