Target: League is over at this time and will resume June 7th. The Cornhusker State Games indoor shoot will be held July 17 & 18 at the range.

Bowhunter: The recent youth only 3-D had 16 shooters, one of whom was a current NASP shooter.

Danny has been busy laying out a 3-D range on the Izaak Walton property for our shoot on June 29-27. The plan is for 40 lanes with 40 different targets.
