1955-2004

Bruce had an unbelievable ability to remember your name even if it had been years since he had last seen you. He was always willing to go the extra mile to make sure you and your equipment were ready to hunt, but more importantly he also wanted to make sure you understood the ethics and responsibilities of being a good Bowhunter. Bruce signed up well over 100 new members for our club during his years at Lincoln Archery, and was always his humble self when it came to taking thanks from our club for his efforts.

We lost Bruce in 2004 after a long battle with cancer. When Bruce passed away, Prairie Bowmen Lincoln proposed a special award in his memory for the biggest Elk. This award is called the Bruce Batterman Memorial Big Elk Award.

#### Secretary/Treasurer Report by Chris Benson

The 6/17/2020 Board meeting was called to order at 7:44 pm at the indoor range.

Board members present were: Jim Tubbs, Chad Morgan, Bob Larsen, Steve Woitazewski, Danny Tubbs, and Chris Benson.

Club members present were: Wes Sheets, Patrick Sullivan, Harry Windle, Tom Runge, and Andy Hatcliff.

Prior to the meeting Betty Lou Cloud from Big Tints presented options for tinting the large windows at the range. Several options are available ranging from approximately \$6.50 to \$9.00 per square foot. After discussion it was decided to proceed with one of the darker tints with the cost not to exceed \$2,000. Betty Lou will get back to the Board with the cost estimate.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Chad stated the league hasn't yet resumed, but plan to start again on Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Bowhunter: Danny reported he intends to resume league on July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Youth:** Steve Has 4-5 people in the current class. Southeast Community College has cancelled all sessions so far with the plan to begin the next on October 27<sup>th</sup>.

Correspondence: Bob said most all of the email problems have been resolved with only one of the last ones sent bouncing back.

**Old Business:** The garage sale held at the outdoor range earlier this month was a little slow, not too many members attending. The club took in about \$1,300 from the sale of miscellaneous small items.

Jim reported he sent gift cards to our landlord in appreciation of her not charging rent for April and May due to the Corvid-19 virus. He also delivered beverages to the auto shop next door for allowing us to attach to his wi-fi.

Chad brought up the need for more Morrell targets. There was a motion and second to order three of them cost of approximately \$475 each. Motion carried.

Danny loaded up the scrap iron at the outdoor range on the old pickup box trailer and took everything to the scrap yard. Proceeds were \$121.

**New Business:** Tom Runge talked about ways to display the "rock" from the outdoor range at our new indoor range. Plans are to get this done ASAP.

A work day is planned for June 27th, 7:00 am at the outdoor range. Everything that is useable or salvageable will have to be removed that day.

We also have a work day planned for July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 9:00 am to spruce up the exterior of the indoor range. Cleanup, weeding, painting, etc.

The Cornhusker State Games and the State 900 are still in the works pending the Corvid-19 virus. We still are waiting for the ok from Game and Parks to use the NOEC ranges to host those events.

July 8<sup>th</sup> there will be a recruitment night at the indoor range for the Big Game Conservation Association and the Prairie Bowmen Archery Club.

New member applications were received and approved from: Laura Navratil, Ethan Bender and the George Venteicher family.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm at the indoor range.
