## President's Message

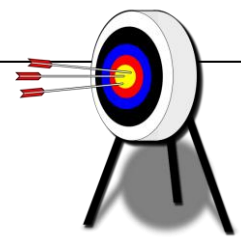

**Target:** Chad said the current target league ends July 26<sup>th</sup> and the next one will start on September 13<sup>th</sup>. The Cornhusker State Games indoor 450 round held at our range went well with 50 shooters. The State Games NASP portion had 35 shooters.
