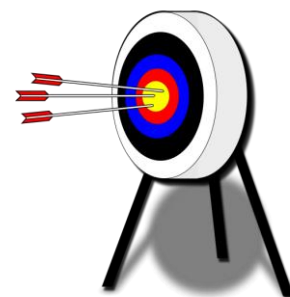

Secretary/Treasurer Report **by Chris Benson**

The 9/15/2020 Board meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm at the indoor range.

Board members present were: Jim Tubbs, Brian Krogman, Bob Larsen, Steve Woitaszewski, Chad Morgan, Danny Tubbs and Chris Benson.

Club members also present were: John Filsinger, Harry Windle and Michael Welsch.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: League started 9/14 (450) round and will continue for 7 weeks. Chad reported we need to have our proposed schedule for 2021 ready by the November 22nd State meeting.

Bowhunter: The August 30 3-D had 8 shooters. Indoor league is over until January. Danny has taken an inventory of our 3-D targets and inserts.

Youth: Steve reported the current class session will conclude at the end of the month. The next session is scheduled to start October 29.

Range Master: Brian reported we need to schedule a work day soon to repair some of our targets. A tentative work day is scheduled for the weekend of November 14-15.

Correspondence: Everything is set for the club election that will be on-line for the first time.

Old Business:

John Filsinger has been appointed Assistant Range Master. His duties will consist of maintaining all electrical components.

Jim is working with three schools interested in using our range for their teams' practicing. We will require each coach to be a club member. We are tentatively looking at charging \$5 per student per session if we supply the equipment.

The Deer and Big Game Expo at the Events Center is scheduled for January 15,16 & 17. We need to purchase backstop material for the event.

At the next work day, we'd like to construct a "memorial wall" on the South wall of the range. This wall will be to honor the members who have had special club awards named after them.

New Business:

Michael Welsch presented a proposal for hosting a tournament at our range. Michael is the USA Archery State Coordinator. This will be the USA Archery & JOAD Nationals. It will be held sometime in the January 1-February 28 time frame. Details are still being ironed out. The Board agreed this is something we should consider.

One of our club members is working on a surveillance system for the range.

Chad and Bob are working on instituting a shoot at the range. It will be called the "Prairie Bowmen Cornhusker Shootout". They'd like to schedule it for the weekend of December 12-13, before the Iowa Pro-Am. The goal is to establish this as our ongoing "signature shoot". They are trying to line up sponsorships, prizes and raffle items. It was moved and seconded to allow them to spend up to \$500 to get this off the ground. Motion carried.

The next meeting is scheduled for October 21st, 7:00 pm at the range.

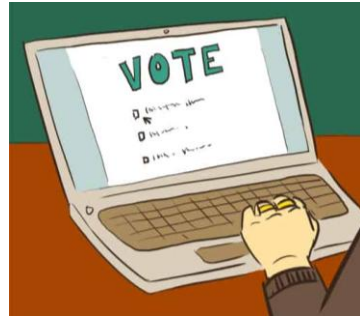
