Secretary/Treasurer Report

The **10/20/2021** Board meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm at the range.

Board members present were: Jim Tubbs, Danny Tubbs, Brian Krogman, Steve Woitaszewski, Chad Morgan and Chris Benson.

Club members present were: John Filsinger, Wes Sheets, Kelly Slama, and Harry Windle.

The Treasurer's report was approved. (No minutes of September's meeting, Secretary was out of town.)

Target: Chad reported the league continues through November. No leagues in December, then will resume on January 6th. The Cornhusker Shootout will be held at the range on December 7th. Chad is working on the plaques, and the club will purchase gift cards for awards.

Bowhunter: Danny reported the 3-D league will start on January 6th.

Youth: Steve reported classes will resume on October 26th. He is expecting around 30 shooters.

Range Master: Brian said there were no problems to report, and the last short work day went well.

Old Business: We plan to purchase 3 or 4 NASP layered targets.

Our banquet is planned for November 20th at 6:00 pm at the range. The new board members will be introduced at that time. The banquet will likely be a pot luck as in recent years.

The Deer & Big Game Expo will be held again on January 14, 15, & 16 at the Lancaster Events Center. We will again have a 90' X 90' space, also a 30' X 55' space for the NASP 3-D.

The NASP 3-D targets ordered a couple of months ago have been delivered.

New business: Election results are in: Target Rep: Chad Morgan; Range Master: Harry Windle, and Correspondence: Kelly Slama.

The schools with NASP programs will again use our range for their classes. These schools are: Southeast, Southwest, East, North Star, and Pius X. The fees will be the same as last year. They will have lanes 1-16 reserved for their days and times. Lanes 17-22 are for club members shooting at those times.

Harry Windle is working on estimates for material to repair our sheds that are attached to the rear of the building.

84 Lumber will again lend us the osb board to use at the Lancaster Event Center for the January EXPO.

The Izaak Walton League will let us continue to host 3-D shoots on their property. It was agreed to see if they would accept \$5 per shooter. They will also allow us to bring in a storage container as long as it is painted and maintained.

The president/secretary meeting will be held on November 21st in Grand Island to select state shoots for 2022.

New member applications were read and approved from the Neil Spencer and William Vaughn families, also Brock Schmidt, Jason Jamison, Mike McBride, Austin Melia, Adam Jirovsky, and student Kelen Meyer.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 20th at 5:30 at the range.

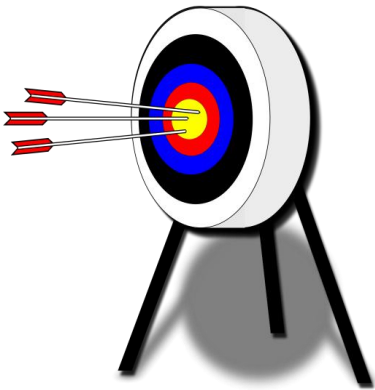
Youth Education Report by Steve Woitaszewski
