The 11/20/2021 Board meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm at the range.

Club members present were: John Filsinger, Harry Windle, Wes Sheets, Janice Tubbs, Kelly Slama, and Kay Larsen.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Chad pointed out the Cornhusker Shootout is coming up December 4&5. He will need help with hosting this event. He is purchasing gift cards soon for awards.

Bowhunter: Danny reported he is looking at the club hosting an "ice-breaker" 3-D shoot out at the Ike's sometime in February. The next 3-D league will start on 1/6/2022.

Youth: Steve reported there are 31 shooters in the current class, approximately 1/3 of whom are adults. This class will continue until the end of the year, then the next session will start two weeks later.

Rangemaster: Brian reported he is looking at rebuilding a couple of target backers before they deteriorate any further.

Correspondence: Bob reported he sent out 400+ emails for the Cornhusker Shootout.

Old Business:

Four "block" type targets for NASP were ordered and received. The NASP 3-D targets are also here.

Jim will be attending the President/Secretaries meeting tomorrow in Grand Island. This meeting is where the State shoots for 2022 will be scheduled.

New business: The NASP schools have scheduled their practice times at the range for this winter. They will have lanes 1-16 for their sessions, and club members will use lanes 17-22.

The Board discussed moving some of our savings account fund into an investment plan. This move is necessary due to the current low interest rates and rising inflation cycle. It was moved and seconded to start by moving approximately 25% of savings into such an account. Motion carried.

New member applications were read and approved for: Sean Johanns, Kamryn Wanser (student) and the David Cleverly, Rusty Hanley, and Mike Sullivan families.

The next meeting is scheduled for December 15th at 7:00pm at the range.
