The 1/19/2022 Board meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at the range.

Minutes of the last meeting were corrected and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Our Presidents' Day shoot will be held February 20th. A NASP 3D will be held February 19th.

Bowhunter: The Thursday night 3D league is back on schedule. Danny has 10 lanes laid out so far at the Lincoln Ike's property for our Icebreaker Shoot scheduled for March 27th.

Youth: There are 41 shooters in the current Monday night class session, with 16 new shooters.

Some discussion was held regarding developing business cards, flyers, etc. to help promote our club.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 16th, 2022 at 7:00 pm at the range.

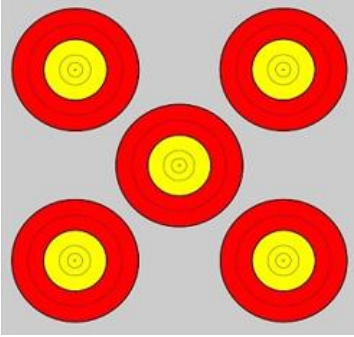
