The April 20, 2022 Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm at the range.

**Board members present:** Jim Tubbs, Chad Morgan, Danny Tubbs, Steve Woitaszewski, Harry Windle, Kelly Slama, and Chris Benson

Club members present: Zee Nelsen, John Filsinger, and Patrick Sullivan

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

<u>**Target:**</u> Chad said league would continue indefinitely, currently there are 16-18 shooters each week. Chad is already starting planning for next December's Cornhusker Shootout.

**Bowhunter:** Danny is planning to have a summer 2D-3D league that will end just before deer season. The 3-D portion of the Cornhusker State Games will consist of 30 targets and be held at the lke's property.

Youth: Steve reported the current JOAD session has 23 shooters, 12 of which are new through Southeast Community College.

Rangemaster: Harry is planning to patch the bad spots on the range floor after work on the restrooms is complete.

Correspondence: Kelly is still working on a business card design for the club.

<u>Old Business</u>: Work on the restrooms continues. Framing is done & drywall is hung, ready to finish. The plan is to have all work done before the Cornhusker State Games.

After the restrooms are done, the plan is to add two heat runs to the spectator area. This should help that area to stay more comfortable year around.

The lke's have made an old trailer available to us for 3-D target storage on their property. This saves us the expense of purchasing a storage container.

A few of the target backers need work, and this needs to be done before the State Games.

The club recently purchased 48 insulated tumblers with the club logo, and over half are already sold.

The Board will be donating a one- year club membership to the Nebraska Big Game Conservation Association for their upcoming banquet.

<u>New Business</u>: New member applications were read and approved for: Brandon Tatge, Sam Ayars, Student Carly Gartner, and the Jeremy Swanson and Nicholas Grandgenett families.

Discussion was held regarding purchasing one or two "adverssail" banners. These are the tall "feather flags" seen around town, used to attract attention. These could be used at the range and also at the lke's to help shooters see where we're located. Jim is looking further into the cost.

The club frequently gets calls wondering if they can go to the range for an hour or two. Since we're not a retail business with employees on site, this can't work. Some discussion was held regarding setting aside one or two evenings per month for that purpose. It was pointed out that these prospective members could also just show up on any league night to shoot.

The next meeting is scheduled for May 20th, 2022 at 7:00 pm at the range.
