The September 27th Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm at the range.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

<u>Target:</u> Chad is planning on a one-day 300 round Thanksgiving Shoot on November 27<sup>th</sup>. It's also time to start preparations for the Cornhusker Shootout coming on December 3-4.

**Bowhunter:** Danny would like to have a forty target Icebreaker shoot, possibly on March 26th. He will also be taking inventory of our 3-D targets.

<u>Youth</u>: Steve reported the JOAD session ended last week. The next one will run from October 18th to December 22nd. There are 39 shooters registered for that session.

**<u>Rangemaster</u>**: Harry plans to repair some of the damaged carpet tiles soon. He would also like to repaint the range floor to make it more presentable. Motion was made and seconded to have him buy the paint. Motion carried.

**<u>Old Business</u>**: Most of the material is now at the range to extend the heat ducts to the shooting line area. Work should be done soon.

Kelly plans to have club business cards by the next Board meeting.

<u>New Business</u>: New member applications were read and approved for students Carrie Terpsma and Gabrielle Stoner, and the Jessica Skretta, Jesse Weir, and Josie Cannon families.

The Nebraska Deer and Big Game Expo will be held January 20-23 at the Events Center.

The Board is looking at hosting a 3-D at Pawnee Lake next year. Also, it appears we can continue to host shoots at the Izaak Walton property.

A date will be set soon to rebuild target butts and getting kits for the kid's NASP targets.

The State Presidents/Secretaries meeting in GI is scheduled for November 20.

Discussion was held regarding building a registration desk possibly in the NW corner of the range. This would be more presentable than a table and move registration away from the bottleneck in causes at our entrance.

The Board is looking into the possibility of hosting a Cornhole tournament possibly on Black Friday. A decision will be made after we determine the cost of renting the equipment necessary. This might be a way to raise more money for the club.

The same four schools (East, Pius, North Star, and Blessed Sacrament) that have been using our range for NASP will be holding tournaments again this winter.
