The October 19th Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm at the range.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

<u>Target:</u> Chad said it was time to send out flyers for the upcoming Cornhusker Shootout scheduled for the first weekend in December. 7 or 8 gift cards are left over from last year's shoot. Awards will be presented if there are at least 3 shooters in the division.

Target league will take a break until after Thanksgiving.

**Bowhunter:** The ice breaker shoot is scheduled for March 19 at the lke's property.

<u>Youth</u>: The current session of JOAD started last night. There were 35 shooters, 19 of which were new. This session will end on December 22nd.

**<u>Rangemaster</u>**: Harry will be replacing the castor wheels on some of the target butts. He also has plans to repair the damaged areas of the floor.

**<u>Correspondence</u>**: Kelly brought the new business cards for the club.

**<u>Old Business</u>**: Material is in to extend the heat ducts; they will be installed as time permits.

<u>New Business:</u> New member applications were read and approved for students Dakota Deebs, Katie Voelker, Emmett Holloway, and the Angela Davison and Kathryn Jensen families.

The 2023 Deer and Big Game Expo will be January 20-22. Jim will be in touch with 84 Lumber to see if we can use the sheets of flakeboard again this year.

Jim and Danny are still working on having a 3-D at Pawnee Lake next year. We would like to have 3, 3-D shoots at the Ike's next summer. Possibly late March, and in July and just before the Cornhusker State Games in August.

Discussion was held regarding rebuilding the remaining target butts and getting kits for the NASP targets. It was moved and seconded to spend up to \$2,000 for these kits. Motion carried.

As soon as the pop machine is moved Harry plans to start on a new registration desk

Discussion was held regarding holding a Cornhole Tournament at the range, possibly on Black Friday. Bob Bruner and John Gerber aided the discussion as they've had experience. Bob also has several sets of the boards and sacks. Plans aren't complete but may include an entry fee of \$30 or \$40 that would include lunch. There will be a payback, possibly 50% to the winners.

The same NASP teams that used our range last year plan to return this year. Same practice schedule as last year.

Ballots for this year's election will be in the next newsletter. Voting will run from November 1-15, with results read at the November 16 Board meeting. Positions open this year are: President, Secretary/Treasurer, and Bowhunter Rep.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 7:00 pm at the range.
