If you have never taken a CPR and First Aid class, I'd strongly suggest taking one. No one takes these classes hoping you'll get to use your knowledge, but if the occasion would present itself, you would know what to do. You could definitely help save a life. We had an incident at target league where an archer went into cardiac arrest, falling and hitting their head, resulting in a skull fracture. Members jumped into action, from calling 911, getting supplies for the head wound, doing CPR, until the 1st responders arrived. We may have very well lost one of our fellow archers, had we not known what to do. It was a great team effort and I'm proud of our club members. Our thoughts and prayer go out for a full recovery!

It was discussed at our February board meeting which was only a couple days after the accident that we want to offer a CPR class to any club member that wants to take it. Cost would be \$60.00 per person and would cover CPR, First Aid and using an AED. We have it on the schedule for Saturday May 13th at 10:00 am. Please let me know if you like to take part in this. Since we also do so many tournaments and 3D's at Ikes, it was suggested that we look into purchasing a portable AED. We are looking for donations, from anyone willing to donate, so far a couple donors have donated \$150.00.

The last Saturday in January and every Saturday in February has been busy at the range. 4 NASP tournaments (503) NASP kids shooting and 51 Archers shooting the Midwest Sectionals. Remember that these kids are the future of our sport. They may not all become bow hunters or target archers, but they have been exposed to the sport. Where they take it from here, is up to them. I believe the weekends are open until April 22nd, when the last NASP tournament will take place.

Last Saturday, February 18th, we held a club banquet. Although not many attended, those that did had a great time and greater food. Thank you!

Before long, outdoor target season, turkey season and outdoor 3D's will be upon us.
