As always, there are many opportunities to do something kind for someone else... just because you can.

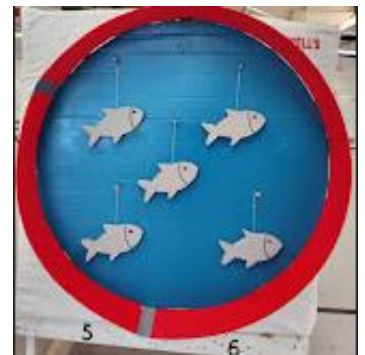
## Youth Education Report
