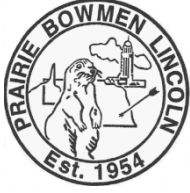

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Brian reported the targets are repaired and ready for the State Games. Indoor target league continues, usually 7-10 shooters.

Bowhunter: Danny reported there were 21 shooters at the 3-D shoot at the Ikes'.

Youth: Steve said the last session ended last week. 48 shooters started the session and 30 finished, which is usual with all the summer activities. The next session will commence on July 16th and will run for 10 weeks.

Rangemaster: Harry will try to remove the stains that keep showing up on our carpet. Over all the range is in good shape.

Old Business: We still need to get together with our landlord to negotiate a new lease.

The workday to rebuild the targets went well. 15 club members showed up and the work was done in record time.
