President's Message

The October 19th workday has come and gone. Thanks to Mike, Caughlin, Danny & Harry for rebuilding the outside storage shed on the back of the range. We even had a neighbor stop by and thanked us for the improvement. It did look pretty bad. We need to redo the door and trim it out and it will be like new. The next project will be to remove the metal siding on the outside of the other two storage units and redo them. (We plan to reuse the metal siding.) Since we are planning to stay here for some time, we want to make sure the outside looks as good as the inside.

NASP League has been going great. The 1st 8-week session during the summer averaged 40 kids per week. We are almost done with the 8-week fall session and have averaged about 35 kids per week. It has been a great success/experiment. The last night will be Thursday November 14th.

NASP practices have already started, with Lincoln North Star practicing on Thursdays. They are practicing from 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm until NASP league is over then will go from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm. South Lincoln Archery Club will start practice on Wednesday November 13th and will be from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm. During these times, they will have lanes 1 – 16 reserved. Club members may still shoot on the remaining lanes but must follow the NASP protocol.

We are hosting the Presidents/Secretary meeting and 300 NFAA round on the weekend of November 23rd -24th.

The annual ballot for the election of officers will be in the November edition of the newsletter. Positions are President, Secretary/Treasurer and Bow Hunter Rep.

Keep January 16th thru the 19th, 2025 on your calendar. This is the date for the Deer & Game Expo. This has been our largest fundraiser the past few years. Move in day is Thursday the 16th, set up the afternoon of the 16th and Friday morning. Need to be ready to go by 3:00 pm on Friday afternoon. We can always use as much help as possible setting up, tearing down on Sunday and running the tournament. Let me know if you can help. I will make sure I get you a pass to get into the show.

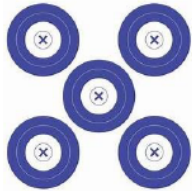

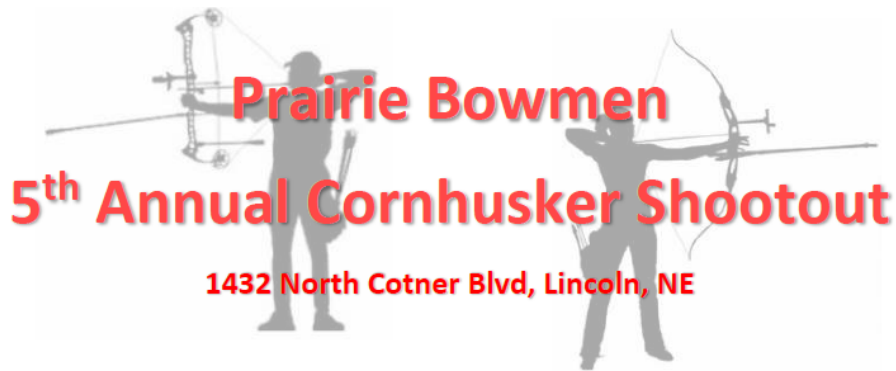

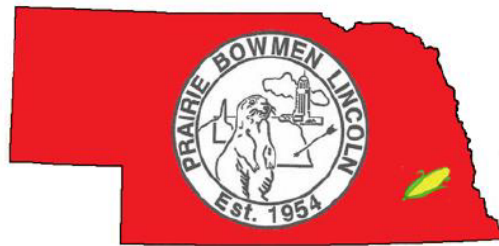
