Since my last term on the Board has ended, I wanted to share some information and thoughts about our Club. Have you ever wondered how much money it takes to keep the Club operating? I've attached a small spreadsheet showing the total income and expenses for the last 5 years.

They have always been a popular event and a nice contribution to the Club income. Surely there is someone in the club who enjoys these shoots and is willing to take on the position? Maybe a couple of people can team up?

One last thought, when the Treasurer sends out your renewal notice, please pay it in a timely fashion. If for any reason you don't intend to renew, kindly let her know! That way her time isn't wasted with sending second notices.

I've been a member of the Prairie Bowmen for nearly 53 years now, and I can tell you that it's still in good shape financially and believe that will continue.
