Secretary/Treasurer Report

The 3/24/26 Board meeting was called to order at 6:05pm at the range.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, followed by the Treasurer's report.

Target: Daric reported we are 2 weeks into Spring target league session with 10 shooters. This will be the last league session until Fall.

Bowhunter: Danny got a quote for replacement cores and a couple of new 3D animals. The quote came in less than he was expecting. Will need to get them ordered so we have them before the May line shoot at Turpin.

Youth Coordinator: Steve reported the next JOAD session starts April 7 and ends on June 16. They will be fixing target bales before the next session starts.

Rangemaster: Harry had nothing new to report.

Old Business: The Pro Archer seminar is set for 5/9. The online registration will be ready soon and posted on FB.

Caughlin made certificates for the volunteers of the year awards & Jim purchased gift cards. They will be presented soon.

Jim plans to take fire extinguishers in for inspection.

Range rules were reviewed and a couple final changes will need to be made.

New Business: New member applications were read and approved for Spencer Lyon, Crystal Dunning & Jeanette Tiwald. All single memberships.

Michael discussed setting up a digital storefront where we can sell PB merch possibly 3 times a year.

Michael requested the club purchase a step stool. Jim will pick one up at Menards.

Michael would like to add a tournament at the end of October/early November that would be a club challenge with South Dakota. We would also like to attract local college shooters for tournaments. He will get with Daric to come up with a plan.

New paper targets have been ordered. We were able to order with Turpin for a larger quantity discount. We also received an events discount, so the cost was lower than expected. Kelly suggested we set up space for slightly used targets for people to re-use them in addition to having new paper targets for sale. This could be set up by the new targets or back by the bales or both areas.

Patrick did a demo of Ticket Tailor that will allow us to set up events online and process credit card payments for a small fee per ticket vs paying a monthly fee. It interfaces with Stripe. We will test this product out for tickets for the pro archer seminar. We may use it for other things in the future.

Jim was informed we would need to create a wall between our shooting area and the Scheels booth for the Deer and Game Expo. Danny built a demo wall which was on display for the meeting. Jim will send photos to Chris Edwards to make sure this is acceptable to Scheels.

A member let Jim know of property for sale that we may want to consider for an outdoor range. It is 20 acres just West of Lincoln. The area was flat and didn't have any trees, so not exactly what we would be looking for.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 16th, 2026 at 6:00pm at the range.

TEAM SHOOT GUIDELINES

- * \$50.00 Per Team - \$5.00 from each shooter goes to Turpin Outdoor Education Center. 50% of remaining shoot fee goes to pay out.
- * 25 Targets for qualifying round. All targets will be 40 to 60 yards. Each team member shoots once - count best arrow. Each team member will have their own score card.
- * Estimated distances will be posted. Range finders are allowed.
- * Scoring - ASA - 12, 10, 8, 5, 0
- * If lost arrows can't be located in 30 seconds you will need to search after shoot is completed.
- * 2 Classes Only - Open Class and Hunter Class
- * Classes will be determined by shoot staff based on equipment.
- * Top 5 scoring teams in each class will have a 5 target shoot off. All scores return to zero. Top 3 scorers in each shoot off class will receive cash prize.
