Just a heads up on what will be going on at the range. The board has decided to do a bit of renovation to the concrete floor, to the east of the carpeted area. WE have hired a company to come in and do an epoxy coating. This will make to range look great, we won't have to continue to repair the floor and has a lifetime warranty. This will be taking place in August, So the range will be closed from Sunday the 16th and reopen on Monday the 24th. This will involve grinding the current finish down to the concrete, filling in any imperfections, sealing the concrete and putting the color down. The next step will be to clean up and add the epoxy coating and the new lines. We will let it cure for 72 hours. Everything will be moved to the carpeted area, in which time we will rebuild a few targets, put new wheels on the target stands and get everything back in place, so we can reopen. We also have a few more housekeeping plans. We will be needing a little help, which we'll be asking for when the time comes.

July looks to be a busy month. Joad, advanced Joad, NASP leagues and Cornhusker State Games (for NASP), will be going on.
