LEGEND

HOW

- **Legislative vehicle**: Since FY 2000, foreign assistance funds have been appropriated either as part of an **omnibus** spending bill (formally titled a consolidated appropriations act), which combines two or more subcommittee appropriations bills into one legislative package; enactment of a freestanding **foreign operations appropriations** subcommittee bill; or in a full-year **continuing resolution (CR)**, which keeps the federal government in operation at the previous fiscal year's funding levels and under existing policy until the end of the fiscal year.
- **No. of Subcommittee Bills Included**: If foreign operations appropriations are included in either an omnibus or full-year CR, the ratio indicates how many other subcommittee bills are included in the final spending vehicle, of which the foreign operations bill is one.

WHEN

- **No. of CRs Required**: The number of continuing resolutions that were required to be passed in order to keep the federal government open after the end of the fiscal year before a legislative vehicle including the foreign operations subcommittee bill could finally be enacted into law. (NOTE: the 15 CRs required in FY 2001 were excluded in calculating the annual average.)
- **<u>Date of Final Enactment</u>**: The date on which the legislative vehicle containing the foreign operations subcommittee bill was enacted and signed into law.
- **No. of Months Delay after the Start of the FY**: The number of months after the start of the fiscal year it took for the foreign operations subcommittee bill to be enacted into law, rounded to the nearest half-month.
