

- Allocate at least 60% of the funding needed to purchase contraceptives each year.
- Respect the commitment to increase the contraceptives budget by at least 10% each year.

Trend Data

- The FP programs allocation as a share of the funding need increased significantly from 3% to 67% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- The contraceptives allocation increased to 45% of the funding need in FY 2019, after remaining at 19% in FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Data are not available on expenditure of funds for FP programs and contraceptives because the budget execution reports present expenditure data aggregated by major budget programs.





Government budget documents must be comprehensive, published in a timely manner and made publicly available on government websites free of charge





Budget Transparency Recommendations

- Facilitate access to budget information for civil society organizations to better support the MoH in its FP activities.
- Create a specific budget line for the purchase of contraceptives.
- Show quarterly disbursements in the contraceptive acquisition table and publish it on the MoH website every six months.
- Make disbursement and expenditure data for FP programs and the purchase of contraceptives available on the MoH website every six months.
