



## **Trend Data**

• No allocation, disbursement nor expenditure data for FP commodities because there is no budget line. FP commodities are combined with maternal health supplies in the RH commodities budget line.

### Adequacy/sufficiency and performance/ownership charts:

• Both the allocation and expenditure for FP programs as a share of total funding need remained under 2% over the three-year period, reaching their highest points at 1.8% in FY 2018.
